Re: Amber Rose Traffic Concerns Recommendation

Date: November 19, 2020

I have read Ms. Rose's concerns and offer the following.

Some of the increased traffic on Dartmouth Dr. may be due to the town's leaf /brush dump being relocated to Hill St. between Asylum St. and Fiskemill Rd. This was done in 2014 because of the limited amount of space at the Transfer Station located on Cedar St. where the leaves and brush used to be dumped. At that time we filed the proper paperwork with the DEP and we were granted a permit for a compost area at that location. We can assume the traffic increases between the months of September and December when the leaves are falling. The leaf dump is open April to January on Thursday and Friday 12pm to 4pm, Saturday 8am to 4pm and Sunday 10am to 4pm.

The new access road being constructed on Countryside Dr. is being built to eliminate traffic problems that are being caused at the Countryside Health Care facility. The exit in front of the facility will be closed permanently. There is also an entrance off Fiskemill Rd that we have found to be very dangerous because of the very close proximity to Rt140 and cars turning on to the road at a very high rate of speed. The ingress may still be utilized as an entrance only. The new access road that is being built off of Countryside Rd. will not be completed until 2022 or later and should not have much effect on the amount of traffic using Dartmouth Dr.

We are in the preliminary stages of possibly moving the entire Transfer Station to the leaf/brush dump. Before we can determine if the move will happen we need to get site assignment and site approval from the DEP. Part of that will be traffic control. The consultant has been informed to make traffic control a priority. The projects time frame is 5 plus years away.

We will work with Chief Pighetti to install any signage as needed or other traffic control devises he thinks are necessary.

Dear Selectman O'Loughlin,

I hope this message finds you well during these strange and difficult times. I'm writing today because I want to discuss an issue we're having in our neighborhood with speeding and an extremely large amount of traffic. I live at 27 Dartmouth Dr. My house is on the corner of Dartmouth and Asylum. The stop sign is actually at the bottom of my driveway. We are a tightknit little neighborhood so we're all in close contact with each other on a regular basis and everyone seems to be concerned. Something that we've all observed over the past few years is that cars are starting to speed through our neighborhood at higher volume and much higher speed. Since Massachusetts went to hands free people often sit at the stop sign at

the bottom of my driveway texting usually with music blasting. Vehicles fly up and down Asylum Street at very high speeds and as you know, there are no sidewalks.

I walk dogs in the neighborhood and have literally had to jump into neighbor's driveways and onto their lawns to keep from getting hit on more occasions than I can count.

Another issue that has been a big problem for years is that people coming out of the country club do not stop at the stop sign and just pull straight out onto Asylum.

GPS has brought about an abundance of traffic in the area as it often will route people through the neighborhood as a shortcut to and from 140.

With all of these things in mind over a dozen neighbors, including myself, have decided that we need to reach out to the board of selectmen to find out what we can do to start putting some things in place to help with the issue. This is a very serious problem.

The other growing concern is that once the access road to the leaf dump is built that it will cause an even bigger surplus of traffic through the neighborhood and exacerbate what is already a huge issue for the people living here.

As you know, there are many kids in this neighborhood and to have people going down Asylum Street at speeds over 50 miles an hour is simply unacceptable.

On a personal note, I'm not sure what can be done, but I'm starting to have an issue getting into my own driveway. This has never been an issue before, but as I previously mentioned there has never been this much traffic in the neighborhood or people sitting at the stop sign texting. I've lived here for 16 years and I've never had such a problem getting into my own driveway as I do now.

I look forward to hearing from you after you have time to review and process this message.


