MINUTES OF REGULAR SESSION – December 2, 2019 ROOM 03 – TOWN HALL 7:00 PM

PRESENT: Chairman William D. Buckley, Selectmen William E. Kingkade, Jr. and Michael K. Walsh and Town Administrator Richard A. Villani.

1. The Board presented a Citation to Sergeant Carlos Sousa for his actions in responding to an emergency call and applying a tourniquet to a Milford Fireman's arm and likely saving his life. Police Chief Michael Pighetti and Fire Chief William Touhey were also present.

2. Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To sign the warrant, UNANIMOUS.

3. Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To approve the Regular Session Minutes of November 18, 2019 as submitted. Mr. Buckley moved to amend the minutes to add the word business to Paragraph 8 at the end of the sentence. Mr. Kingkade seconded the motion. UNANIMOUS.

4. A public Hearing was held regarding an all alcohol license being held by Milford Restaurant Holdings, LLC to determine whether the licensee violated MGL chapter 138, Section 77 by closing, ceasing operations, and/or otherwise failing to use or exercise the said alcoholic beverage license. Attorney Joseph Antonellis appeared representing Milford Restaurant Holdings, LLC. Town Counsel Charles Boddy, Jr. represented the Town. Attorney Boddy offered that the licensee purchased the license in November 2016, that the license has not been used and the listed manager was not present. Attorney Antonellis offered that the owner of the license has rehabilitated the K Mart Plaza and that this client had no intent to "Pocket" the license but was hoping to attract a small restaurant to the Plaza. He also stated his client expended the sum of \$75,000.00 to redo the traffic lights on Route 109. Town Counsel suggested that Milford Holdings waive their right to appeal if the Town vacates the License and the Town give the licensee until January 13, 2020 to effectuate a transfer of the license. Attorney Antonellis believes his client would agree to this proposal, but needed time to speak with his client and secure the agreement to waive any appellate rights. Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh to continue the hearing until Thursday, December 5, 2020 at 7 PM. UNANIMOUS.

5. A public Hearing was held regarding a Wine and Malt License being held by Mango Tree, Inc. to determine whether the licensee violated MGL chapter 138, Section 77 by closing, ceasing operations, and/or otherwise failing to use or exercise the said alcoholic beverage license. No one from Mango Tree, Inc. appeared at the Hearing. Town Counsel Boddy offered that the license was issued on June 13, 2017, the licensee is no longer in business at 206 Main Street and there is no current lease for those premises. Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh to revoke license number 03478- RS-0706 held by Mango Tree, Inc. UNANIMOUS.

6. Representatives from Rentschler Biopharma, Inc., Karen Savage, Vice President, Diraj Dass, Senior Vice President, John Leozos, Senior Director Engineering, Bob Donovan, Senior Director, Finance and Controller were present along with their Government Tax Incentives Consultant, Lynn Tokarczyk to discuss their application for a Tax Incremental Financing (TIF) under the Massachusetts Economic Development Incentive Program. Members of the Town Working Group, Chairman Bill Buckley, Town Counsel Charles Boddy, Jr. and Town Administrator Richard Villani were also present. The Board reviewed a draft TIF Agreement negotiated by Rentschler representatives and the Working Group. Rentschler is a privately held family owned life science company which develops and manufactures transformative medicines to improve the lives of patients with serious or rare diseases. They acquired property at 27 Maple Street in January 2019. They are considering a 24,000 square foot on-site expansion to add a building to create a campus environment. The project investment is estimated at \$55 million which consists of \$46 million in hard and soft construction costs and \$9 million in personal property. They will retain 85 full-time jobs and create 75 new permanent full-time jobs. They stated they will spend an estimated \$1 million locally in Milford. Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To recommend to Town Meeting the Tax Increment Financing Agreement in accordance with the provisions of the Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 59, Section 40 between the Town of Milford and Rentschler Biopharma Inc. and to approve the submission of the Rentschler Biopharma Inc. EDIP Local Incentive Only Application to the Massachusetts Economic Assistance Coordinating Council in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 23A, Sections 3(A) and 3(C). UNANIMOUS.

7. Justin Jaundoo, Director of Corporate Development from Interactions, Inc. was present along with their Government Tax Incentives Consultant, Lynn Tokarczyk to discuss their application for a Tax Incremental Financing (TIF) and a Personal Property Tax Exemption under the Massachusetts Economic Development Incentive Program. Members of the Town Working Group, Chairman Bill Buckley, Town Counsel Charles Boddy, Jr. and Town Administrator Richard Villani were also present. The Board reviewed a draft TIF Agreement negotiated by Interactions, LLC representatives and the Working Group. They are a privately held global technology company which builds and delivers omnichannel Intelligent Virtual Assistant applications. They are considering moving to Milford to lease a 52,000 square foot vacant building at 31 Maple Street for their corporate headquarters and technology operations. Their anticipated investment is estimated at \$7 million. They will relocate 200 full time jobs and create 100 new permanent full-time jobs to Milford. They stated they will spend an estimated \$700,000.00

locally in Milford. Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To recommend to Town Meeting the Tax Increment Financing Agreement in accordance with the provisions of the Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 59, Section 40 between the Town of Milford, Interactions LLC and an affiliate of Rhino Capital Advisors LLC and to approve the submission of the Interactions LLC EDIP Certified Project Application to the Massachusetts Economic Assistance Coordinating Council in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 23A, Sections 3(A) and 3(C). UNANIMOUS.

8. Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To schedule a Special Town Meeting date for Monday, January 13, 2020 at 7 PM in Upper Town Hall, UNANIMOUS.

9. The Board reviewed a draft Warrant for the Special Town Meeting scheduled for January 13, 2020. Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To approve the draft Warrant. UNANIMOUS.

10. Town Counsel Charles Boddy, Jr. was present to discuss property at 142 Purchase Street. The Town foreclosed its tax lien on the property and the right of redemption period has expired. An interested Buyer has come forward. He requested the Board put this matter on a future Agenda to discuss if there is an interest in declaring the property surplus and offering it for sale. Chairman Buckley asked if there are other properties where the right of redemption has expired. Town Counsel said there are other such properties and he will have the Town Treasurer prepare a list of the properties for the Board to review.

11. Building Commissioner Matt Marcotte was present to introduce the newly hired Local Building Inspector, Dana Hinthorne and Assistant Zoning Officer Chris Williams who were also present. The Board welcomed them as new Town employees. The Board members congratulated Mr. Marcotte for passing the required exams to be a certified as Building Commissioner. Mr. Kinkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To formally appoint Matt Marcotte as the certified Building Commissioner for the Town of Milford. UNANIMOUS. The Board next discussed a salary increase for Mr. Marcotte. Chairman Buckley stated there was a discussion at a prior Personnel Board meeting to hold off on salary discussion until Mr. Marcotte was appointed as a certified Building Commissioner. Mr. Buckley said he was inclined to offer a salary at Level 4, Step 5 under Article 2 of \$90,396. Mr. Kingkade stated the minimum he would recommend would be a salary at Level 4, Step 6 under Article 2 of \$94,811. Mr. Walsh stated it was time to compensate the Building Commissioner fairly due to the expectations of the position. Mr. Kinkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To recommend to the Personnel Board a salary at Level 4, Step 6 under Article 2 of \$94,811. UNANIMOUS.

12. Mr. Kingkade requested the information regarding the IT Department he asked for at the last meeting. He requested this be on the next Selectmen Agenda.

13. ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT – December 2, 2019

A. Tree Planting – I want to thank Tree Warden Chuck Reneau, Parks Director Jim Asam, Highway Supervisor John Perry and Fire Chief Bill Touhey for providing labor and equipment to plant 40 Arborvitae trees on the berm along the Parking lot at Countyside of Milford. This will provide screening for the Town composting area. I also want to thank Domenic Afonso of D &F Afonso Builders for their very generous donation for the purchase of the Trees.

B. Special Legislation for Additional Liquor License for Canvas n Cup – Representative Murray has informed the Town that the House has engrossed (in final form) the local bill granting an additional wine and malt liquor license to the Canvas n Cup of 189 Main Street. The bill will now move to the Senate.

C. Christmas Wreaths- I want to thank Facilities Director Carlos Benjamin and Fire Chief Touhey and members of the Fire Department for their assistance in putting up the Christmas Wreaths in time for the Santa Parade. Their commitment of their time and efforts is most appreciated.

14. Mr. Buckley asked the Town Administrator to contact the Highway Surveyor to request he plow Exchange Street to open up the road for parking.

15. After reviewing the list of 2020 License Renewals and determining that the ones listed in red owed taxes: Mr. Kingkade moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To approve all the licenses listed in black, UNANIMOUS.

16. After further discussion and review of the licensees that owe taxes; and in accordance with the Municipal Modernization Act, one of the provisions of this bill which allows the Town to deny local licenses and permits to any taxpayer who has neglected or refused to pay local taxes, including the failure to pay fiscal year 2020 taxes. Moved, seconded by Mr. Walsh: To approve the licenses listed in red subject to the payment of all outstanding taxes. UNANIMOUS.
