

MINUTES OF REGULAR SESSION – December 12, 2011

ROOM 03-TOWN HALL

7:00PM

PRESENT: Chairman Dino B. DeBartolomeis; Selectmen Brian W. Murray and William D. Buckley; Town Administrator Louis J. Celozzi; and Minutes Recorder Jean M. DeTore.

1. Chairman DeBartolomeis presented a Citation to the Milford Permanent Firefighters Association- Local 2140 in recognition of their community spirit and kindness in sponsoring the Annual Santa Parade. Sean Meehan, President, John DePaolo and Brian Dubovsky were present to accept the citation. He also thanked Committee Members Michael Curley, Michael DeTore, Patrick Evans and Michael Goncalves for their part in organizing this annual event.

Firefighter Meehan stated that on Thursday, December 15, 2011 Fire Chief Touhey would be sending Ladder 1 to cover the city of Worcester as part of a Task Force consisting of thirteen surrounding towns, along with honor guards and firefighters in uniform to pay their respect to the Worcester firefighter who died in the line of duty.

2. Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley: To sign the warrant and approve the minutes of November 28, 2011 as submitted, UNANIMOUS.

3. Envoy David Irwin of the Milford Salvation Army was present to introduce himself to the community and to outline the current programs, fund drives and need for volunteers during these difficult financial times. He expressed appreciation to the community for their support and indicated that he and his wife are looking forward to maintaining and expanding the local corps' programs. He urged the community to continue to support the Salvation Army in their fundraising efforts as more people are now in need of services. He emphasized the need of toys, turkeys and monetary donations. At Thanksgiving they distributed to 257 families totaling 901 family members for the towns of Milford, Hopedale and Mendon. To date, for Christmas, they have received applications for 485 families totaling over 1,000 family members and 410 are children 12 and under. He stated that if anyone is interested in donating a turkey, please bring it to 29 Congress Street between 9AM and 2PM on December 19 or 20th, as they will be distributing them on December 21, 2011, however, someone will be at this location Monday-Friday.

4. Citizen Participation – None.

5. Chairman DeBartolomeis welcomed Chris Watson from Boy Scout Troop 4 who was in attendance as part of a badge requirement.

6. Mr. Paul Winshman, Richard's Food and Drink, Inc. d/b/a Maria's, 67 Medway Road was present seeking an Entertainment License. Hours of operation would be Monday-Saturday

from 8:00PM-11:30PM. Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley To approve the license, UNANIMOUS.

7. Mr. Adilson Vieira and Neide Santos, Eva's Restaurant and Pizzeria, 55 Water Street were present seeking a Common Victualler License. Hours of operation would be Sunday – Saturday 10:00AM-11:00PM. Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley: To approve the license, UNANIMOUS.

8. At 7:20 PM a public hearing was held as a result of the Board's intention to amend the Liquor Licensing Rules. Town Counsel Moody reviewed the language which the Board of Selectmen proposes to enact including a new Section 1.07 of the "General Rules Applicable To All Premises License For The Sale of Alcoholic Beverages To Be Consumed On The Premises. As this was a public hearing, Chairman DeBartolomeis recognized Manuel Clavijo (Fr. Manny) who voiced his concerns from a Humanitarian point of view stating that he was concerned for the children of any illegal immigrants detained as a result of local businesses identified as hiring undocumented workers. He stated that these families migrate to the United States for financial opportunities.

Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley: To approve 1. A new Section 1.07 of the Town of Milford's Liquor License Regulations replacing the current Section 1.07. This new section includes placing conditions upon liquor license holders forbidding use of undocumented workers and a further condition that all license holders comply with Federal Department of Homeland Security requirements including I-9 process. UNANIMOUS. Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley: To 2. Strikes Section 1.02B of the current regulations. Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley: To accept the 99 Restaurant Responsible Service of Alcohol Training Program and Test as being in compliance with the Town of Milford Liquor License Regulations.

After reviewing correspondence from Town Administrator Celozzi regarding Amendments- Town of Milford Liquor License Regulations, Mr. Murray requested that the sentence "Proposed amendments addressed that evening included the following", be replaced with "After the posted hearing and public comment, the Board unanimously approved the following amendments:".

9. TOWN ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

- Monthly Financial Update – All budgets under the jurisdiction of the Board of Selectmen are on target.
- Evergreen Center – I again would like to thank the Evergreen Center for their annual yearly visit and the gift of a Christmas wreath which adorns Town Hall. We look forward to the yearly visit from the students and we appreciate their kindness.
- Annual Licenses – I'd like to remind all license holders that all 2012 licenses, which the Board will approve this evening, will be available for pick-up any time after December

- 13, 2011. Obviously, the last date for pick-up is Friday, December 30, 2012 and any business not picking up their license will be closed effective January 1, 2012.
- The Finance Committee's Budget Subcommittee met on Thursday, December 8, 2011. They are requesting budgets be submitted by the end of January 2012 and should reflect no more than a 2% increase.

11. Town Administrator Celozzi reviewed the selection process used by the Designer Selection Committee for Consulting and Engineering Services and Repainting and Masonry Repairs as follows:

1. Developed the Request for Qualifications (RFQ)

2. Advertised, as required, in the Milford Daily News on November 2, 2011 and in the Central Register on November 2, 2011.

3. Proposal packets were due on November 22, 2011 at 2:00PM at which time they were opened by Mr. Celozzi and Mr. Santora. Seventeen (17) firms had requested and received, the RFQ. Two (2) proposals were received, The Preservation Partnership and tbc Architects, LLC. He further explained that after the RFQ opening, the DSC evaluated both proposals thoroughly and is providing the following ranking in order of qualifications:

1. The Preservation Partnership
2. tbc Architects, LLC

According to the DSC, Max Ferro and The Preservation Partnership clearly appeared to be the superior firm. Mr. Celozzi also noted that Mr. Ferro has had a longtime relationship with the Town of Milford serving as our architect on many projects including the repainting of the exterior of Town Hall on two occasions, the interior and restoration of the Upper Hall, the restoration of Memorial Hall, the replacing of the floor in the Upper Hall and assisted on various other smaller projects in the past years. Therefore, based on his qualifications, the DSC recommends that Mr. Ferro and The Preservation Partnership be awarded the contract for this project.

Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley: To support the recommendation of the DSC to award the contract for Consulting Service and Structural Engineering related to repainting the Milford Town Hall, rebuilding the steps to both side entrances and providing a granite ramp to gain accessibility to the platform of the WWI memorial at Draper Park, to the Preservation Partnership in the amount \$38,000, UNANIMOUS.

12. Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley: To approve a permit to obstruct for the Reach the Beach Relay, Inc. for May 18 and 19, 2012 from 7:45PM-2:15AM, UNANIMOUS.

13. Mr. Murray moved, seconded by Mr. Buckley: To approve Temple Beth Shalom's placing of the Menorah in Draper Park one week prior to December 20, 2011, the first evening of Hannukah, UNANIMOUS.

14. The Board reviewed correspondence from Larry Dunkin, AICP Town Planner regarding the proliferation of signs in the downtown area as well as the response from John Erickson, Building Commissioner. Chairman DeBartolomeis noted that enforcement of the Zoning bylaw was already in progress targeting businesses not in compliance and the results of that effort should be noticeable shortly.

15. Mr. Buckley requested that the Zoning Enforcement Officer investigate the increase of signs and promotions in the parking lot advertised by Scioli's Pizza Bar, 146 South Main. He requested a determination if they were licensed for these activities and that a letter be sent notifying them of any violations.

16. The Board reviewed correspondence from John Erickson, Building Commissioner, detailing the recent efforts of the Neighborhood Task Force. A list of violations for properties on South Bow Street was submitted. The members of the Board agreed that this was a consistent measured approach to fix infractions and protect residents and public safety personnel.

18. The Board reviewed correspondence from the Board of Health regarding a request to post a “No Dumping” sign on town owned land on Carroll Street. Chairman DeBartolomeis also noted the continuing dumping problem on Countryside Drive. He requested that Town Engineer Santora survey the site to determine if other preventative measures can be initiated e.g. large boulders, cement posts, etc. and requested Chief O’Loughlin determine if police patrols can assist with this problem.
