## MINUTES OF REGULAR SESSION –DECEMBER 12, 2012

PRESENT: Chairman Brian W. Murray; Selectman William D. Buckley; Town Administrator Louis J. Celozzi; and Minutes Recorder Jean M. DeTore. Selectman Dino B. DeBartolomeis was absent.

- 1. Mr. Buckley moved, seconded by Chairman Murray: To sign the warrant and approve the Minutes of December 3, 2012 as submitted, UNANIMOUS.
- 2. Citizen Participation None.
- 3. Mr. Buckley moved, seconded by Chairman Murray: To approve the Traffic Aid request to install a sign: "NO TRUCK PARKING, STOPPING OR STANDING" on both sides of Sumner Street from Glines Avenue to MECO pole #26. This will address the problem of Benjamin Moore Co. delivery trucks that arrive prior to the plant opening causing a noise problem for residents on Sumner Street, UNANIMOUS. (Note: Benjamin Moore Co. has agreed to pay for the signs.)
- 4. Mr. Buckley moved, seconded by Chairman Murray: To accept the \$50.00 gift from Wayne and Nancy Courtney to be deposited in the Milford Fire Department Gift Account, UNANIMOUS.
- 5. Mr. Buckley moved, seconded by Chairman Murray: To accept the \$100.00 gift from Birch Hill Condo Association to be deposited in the Milford Fire Department Gift Account, UNANIMOUS.

### 6. TOWN ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

- Town Administrator Celozzi advised the Board that Governor Deval Patrick has sought Legislative approval for emergency 9C reductions in unrestricted General Government aid of 1%. This would result in a \$25,000 decrease in Milford. The Legislature has delayed any action until the next session as they would like to review the next few months revenues.
- 7. Town Administrator Celozzi informed the Board that copies of resumes of all Town Administrator applicants are available for member's review. Chairman Murray noted that the members should review the resumes over the holidays and then the Board will make a determination of who will be interviewed. He noted that if two members of the Board approve an applicant then that candidate will be placed on the list for an interview.
- 8. Mr. Buckley moved, seconded by Chairman Murray: To adjourn the Selectmen's meeting at 6:41PM, UNANIMOUS.
