#### Minutes from the Meeting of March 20, 2013

On Wednesday, March 20, 2013, a meeting of the Milford Commission on Disability (MCOD) was held at Milford Town Hall. Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by M. Nicholson, Chairperson.

<u>Members Present:</u> Mike Nicholson, Demetra Edwards, Dino DeBartolomeis, Harold Rhodes, Fran O'Neill and Tom Andruskevich.

<u>Members Unable to Attend:</u> Charles Hince, Theresa Calcagni.

**Guests of the Commission:** Alice Knowlton, Jeff Dougan.

<u>Minutes:</u> Minutes from the February 20, 2013 meeting were reviewed. H. Rhodes moved to accept as written and D. DeBartolomeis seconded the motion. Minutes were accepted by unanimous vote.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Main Account balance \$371.27. Revolving Account balance \$6,421.86. H. Rhodes moved to accept, seconded by F. O'Neill. Report was accepted by unanimous vote.

<u>Correspondence:</u> 1) M. Nicholson received a letter from R. Fitzpatrick RE his Eagle Scout project, building a gazebo at Louisa Lake; he answered MCOD questions that had been raised about accessibility, 2) Town Administrator memo RE new allowance for mileage is 56½ cents/mile.

#### Discussion with Jeff Dougan of Massachusetts Office on Disability (MOD:

- Jeff distributed printed materials from MOD, and reviewed goals and by-laws established for commissions on disability in the Commonwealth
- He offered to assist with any surveys of town buildings and is willing to work with the new Town Administrator, Richard Villani, in his role as ADA Coordinator for Milford
- Jeff said he will promote accessible parking pavement stenciling with the Regulations Review Subcommittee of the Massachusetts Architectural Access Board
- In response to the question whether the ADA is stricter than MAAB, Jeff said the Massachusetts Commission Against Discrimination mirrors Title III of the ADA
- Low flying "Open" flags in front of businesses in Milford need to be individually examined as potential violations, according to Jeff, who had asked the MAAB for their opinion
- Jeff said locator tones on crossing signal posts are not yet required by the ADA, but an individual with a disability can always make a reasonable accommodation request

#### **Review of Current Projects:**

- (a) Accessibility-Businesses:
  - 1) MCOD will be sending a mailing to seventy-nine medical facilities in Milford re compliance with new ADA regulations dealing with access for mobility impaired patients.
  - H. Rhodes said he will send a sample to each MCOD member.
  - 2) Expansion of the ICU and ER at Milford Regional Medical Center: H. Rhodes has been appointed to the hospital Board of Trustees.
  - 3) Milford TV: M. Nicholson sent a note to Building Commissioner J. Erickson RE access issues.

## (b) Site and Building Plan Reviews:

- 1) Cornerstone Assisted Living: M. Nicholson will send questions to the building architect about the accessibility of the rooms and the equipment for use by individuals with disabilities.
- 2) Blaire House: As of March 5, M. Nicholson had not received building plans from J. Erickson.
- 3) M. Nicholson submitted comments to the Town Planner RE 35 Birch Street (Site\_212).

## (c) Town Accessibility:

- 1) <u>Louisa Lake:</u> Accessible platform; M. Nicholson is waiting for sketches from Town Engineer Mike Santoro of a plan to construct a ~20X20 ft platform as close to the water as possible; another meeting to discuss building the platform is necessary.
- 2) <u>Upper Charles Trail:</u> A letter has been received from the owners of the land near CVS licensing the use of their land for construction of an accessible family rest area at that location; the owners have agreed to allow access to the whole property (approximately 5,000 sq ft); M. Nicholson sent information about accessible benches to Mike Bresciani, Parks Commissioner, and members of the MUCT committee.
- 3) Accessible Voting Booths: M. Nicholson reported that the booths have arrived.
- 4) <u>Town By-laws:</u> T. Andruskevich reported that Town Counsel has agreed to place an article in the next Town Meeting Warrant to change the Town By-laws on Handicapped Accessibility to comply with 521 CMR.
- 5) <u>Accessible Parking at Post Office</u>: Rte 16 renovations eliminated the HP spot in front of the PO; M. Nicholson said Town Engineer Mike Santoro supported and the Board of Selectmen have approved replacement with a new HP spot across the street.
- 6) Accessible Transportation for Milford Residents: Discussion of the lack of such transportation; D. DeBartolomeis suggested bringing up this issue again in a few months.

#### (d) Disability Awareness:

MCOD Web Site: T. Andruskevich has reviewed the web site and will submit changes to the Town Webmaster.

(e) <u>Conflict of Interest Training:</u> M. Nicholson again reminded the members they are required to complete the online training.

Next Meeting: Wednesday, April 17, 2013, 7:00 p.m., Room 14, Milford Town Hall.

<u>Adjournment:</u> Meeting adjourned at 9:24 PM, on a motion by H. Rhodes, seconded by D. Edwards. Motion passed unanimously.
