## Minutes from the Meeting of July 17, 2012

On Tuesday, July 17, 2012, a meeting of the Milford Commission on Disability (MCOD) was held at Milford Town Hall. Meeting was called to order at ~7:05 PM by M. Nicholson, Chairperson.

<u>Minutes:</u> Minutes from the June 19, 2012, meeting were reviewed. D. Edwards moved to accept the minutes as submitted; seconded by P. Luchini. Motion was unanimously accepted.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Main Account balance \$1,110.00. Revolving Account balance \$1,421.86. D. Edwards moved to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded by T. Calcagni. Motion was unanimously accepted.

## **Review of Current Projects:**

- (a) <u>Accessibility-Businesses:</u> 1) Medical Facilities/List, Survey: no change; 2) License Renewal/List, Survey: no change; 3) 21 Claudette Drive: 'No Parking' sign to be installed, awaiting curb cut; 4) Sunbridge/Milford Care and Rehabilitation Center, no change; 5) 1 Maple Street: re blocked sidewalk, no change.
- (b) <u>Site & Building Plan Reviews:</u> 27 Maple St. (196): Requested various accessible parking and accessible route changes.
- (c) Town Accessibility:
  - 1) Youth Center: No Change.
  - 2) Pedestrian Crossing Devices: No change.
  - 3) <u>Louisa Lake:</u> Ad hoc committee meeting scheduled for 7/18 at Town Hall to discuss next steps, M. Nicholson to participate.
  - 4) Library: 7/12/12 MDN Article noted re Town Library plan to provide 'accessible' furniture;
  - D. Edwards to check on Perkins School Talking Books brochures placed at the library.
  - 5) <u>Upper Charles Trail:</u> M. Nicholson and D. Edwards will work as a sub-cmte to advise the Friends of the UCT on what MCOD could recommend to make the trail more accessible.
  - 6) Parks Department Parking: goal is additional HP spots at the Upper Charles Trail;
  - T. Andruskevich is exploring with M. Bresciani.
  - 7) <u>Milford Housing Authority:</u> A permanent ramp has been installed to make the laundry facility building at Fairfield Court accessible. Next project will be looking into a ramp to make the laundry facilities accessible at Birmingham Court.
  - 8) <u>Sidewalk Obstructions:</u> (b) E Main St-Prairie St-Quarry Sq: new curb cuts and other alterations are needed: M. Nicholson is working on this; (d) Rte 140 & Water St Intersection

- (c) Town Accessibility (cont'd):
  - 8) <u>Sidewalk Obstructions, cont'd:</u> Renovation: M. Nicholson is waiting to see site plan; (<u>k</u>) W. Spruce St/Gibbons Ave: (mail box and news box encroachment), M. Nicholson will
  - follow up; (m) Crosswalk on Winter Street: (needs curb cuts): M. Nicholson will monitor;
  - ( $\underline{p}$ ) Purchase St sidewalk between Greenleaf Terrace and Pete's Market is narrow and is not level, M. Nicholson will take pictures and follow up; ( $\underline{s}$ ) Problem with flags hanging too low over the sidewalk in front of business establishments, T. Andruskevich is following up.
  - 9) <u>High School Fields:</u> No Change.
  - 10) <u>Draper Park Ramp:</u> MCOD has received plans for a permanent ramp for the WW1 Memorial. M. Nicholson to check on construction status.
  - 11) Fino Field Pool Renovations: Waiting for plans for MCOD to review when M. Bresciani gets them from the architect.
  - 12) <u>Proposed Playground at Fino Field</u>: A group working to build a new playground at Fino Field is taking steps to ensure it will be accessible.
  - 13) Woodland Parking: No Change.
  - 14) <u>Town by-Laws</u>: T. Andruskevich and T. Calcagni will work as a sub-committee to review current Milford By-Laws regarding accessibility issues and report their findings.
- (d) <u>HP Violation Signage:</u> No change; 12 signs in inventory at Dept. of Inspections.
- (e) <u>Disability Awareness</u>: T. Andruskevich will draft publicity for local media about the availability of Voter Assist Terminals at each polling place in Milford before the fall elections.
