

**MILFORD COUNCIL ON AGING

Tony Grillo, Vice Chairperson, called the November Meeting of the Council on Aging to order at 10:07 a.m.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:**

Vincent Squiciari read the October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2010 meeting minutes. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Tony Grillo and it was seconded by Vincent Squiciari. The motion passed unanimously.

**BUDGET REPORT:**

Expenses for October included \$4,116.00 for the van, \$148.57 for telephone, \$427.75 for office supplies and postage, and \$696.20 for facility expenses which include annual fire suppression device inspection which costs about \$400 annually, for a total of \$5,388.52, leaving a balance of \$39,846.98.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

SeniorTax Relief Program

This is a very good program which involves a lot of work to prepare. Forty four application packets were distributed. Forty one of these were returned. Three applicants were over-income and therefore ineligible. There were 21 returning volunteers. One returning applicant withdrew her application. The Board of Selectmen allocated two more positions so 27 applicants will be placed.

Annual Expo

This was cancelled for this year because not enough vendors reserved booths. We usually have 28 to 30 vendors and only 12 reserved this year.

Ruth Anne is open to suggestions about ways to revive this useful event.
