<u>Budget Summary Update:</u> Marc Schaen reported that the general budget is \$219,000 in the red at present. \$1 million for Stabilization; \$688,000 for Overlay account; \$750,000 for IT budget; \$44.2 million for School; \$839,000 for Snow and Ice budget (deficit).

IT Budget: Paul Blivees and Rick Villani reported that the Personnel Budget is \$261,777 for FY16; General Expense budget is \$467,877; School budget is \$90,500; Town budget is \$42,600. Discussions followed regarding Bandwidth for school including the E-Rate reimbursement of 60 percent; private network for \$55,000 including Milford High School, Brookside, Stacy, Memorial and Woodland Schools. Also discussed: tying in the Town Hall, Police and Fire Stations and the Library. The FinCom was assured by Mr. Blivees and Mr. Villani that the \$90,500 for the School IT Budget is all they will spend for FY16. Al Correia moved to accept the \$467,877 for the FY16 proposed budget, seconded by Aldo Cecchi, all in favor.
