- 2, Special Injury Leave Indemnity Fund Police/Fire for \$250,000. Rick Villani gave a brief description of the fund. Marc Schaen moved favorable, seconded by Jeff Niro, Unanimous
- **9,** Establish PEG Access and Cable Related Fund- State is now mandating the creation of this run. Milford TV is required to report back to the selectmen annually. This creates a reserve account that can only be spent for Milford TV. Al Correia motioned favorable, Chuck Miklosovich seconded, Unanimous
- 12, Accept Gift of Land 8 Park Terrace- This is land owned by the Milford National Trust and will be used for the police department to park cars. Al Correia moved to refer to sponsor, Mike Soares seconded, Unanimous.

- 16, Fund Regional Substance Abuse Outreach Program- \$28,000: There is currently an earmark from the state for \$84,000. Other towns can participate in the program at a cost of \$1 per capita. Chuck Miklosovich moved favorable, Al Correia seconded, Unanimous
- 21, Install Permitting Management Software-\$9,000- The current software is outdated and no longer supported. The new software will allow for GIS integration. Includes employee training on how to use the software. Michael Nicholson moved favorable, Al Correia seconded, Unanimous
- 26, Fund Land Takings/Easements Rte 16/140 TIP Project- This will put money into a fund to reserve money for land takings for the intersection improvements. The project is being advanced and may be implemented in '18 instead of '19. \$200,000 is the suggested money however the town is unsure what the final number will be. Marc Schaen moved favorable, Chuck Miklosovich seconded, Unanimous
- 29, Fund Fire Collective Bargaining Agreement- \$90,000 is the estimated number. Al Correia moved favorable, Marc Schaen seconded, Unanimous

Our currently liability is \$126,000,000. We currently have \$73,000,000 funded leaving a gap of \$53,000,000 to be funded by 2035. Marc Schaen moved favorable, Al Correia seconded, Unanimous.

- 35, Add to Liability Claims Insurance Fund- We have had more claims than anticipated and more expenses than were expected. This funding will restore its balance. \$300,000- Marc Schaen moved favorable, Al Correia seconded, Unanimous.
