Article 7 - School Committee - \$150,000 for construction of a parking lot across from Memorial School: Paul Mazzachelli reported that he needs \$150,000 to construct a parking lot on the Walnut Street site. Both he and Bob Trembley met with Mr. Quinn and Scott Crisafulli and were told that he can be done for under \$50,000. Aldo Cecchi moved for a favorable recommendation, seconded by Mike Schiavi, all in favor. (9-0)

Article 3 – Personnel Board – New Position - Milford Youth Center Summer Camp Counselor: Dave Morganelli moved for a favorable recommendation, seconded by Mike Schiavi, all in favor. (9-0)

<u>Article 6 – David Breen – All alcohol license for Fun Zone</u>: Dave Morganelli moved to refer to sponsor, seconded by Aldo Cecchi, all in favor. (9-0)

<u>Article 12 – Fire Chief - \$150,000 for a new rescue truck:</u> Aldo Cecchi moved for a favorable recommendation, seconded by Chuck Miklosovich, all in favor. (9-0)

Debt Schedule: Barbara Auger, Town Treasurer, reported that the net debt for 2012 is \$2,981,650; Long Term Debt as of 6-3-10 is \$38,889,556.

Funding for the Field Project will be \$2,000,000 borrowed and \$1,000,000 from Free Cash.

\$500,000 will be put toward the Tax Rate.

Vinny Valastro moved to accept the present Recap Sheet, seconded by Mike Schiavi, 6 in favor, 3 opposed.

<u>Article 24 – Finance Committee – Stabilization Account:</u> Mike Schiavi moved for a favorable recommendation, seconded by Vinny Valastro, 6 in favor, 3 opposed.
