

How to prepare trash and recycling for collection

NO mattresses.

All mattresses and box springs must be taken to the Transfer Station at 95 Cedar St, Milford MA to be recycled. \$20 per mattress or box spring. No sticker required.





Bag and Bin your trash.

It is mandatory that all trash be bagged and placed in a barrel with a tight-fitting lid. This helps prevent rats and other animals from tearing into your items.

NO yard waste or construction materials.

Yard waste can be disposed of at the Compost Facility located on Fiske Mill Road, Milford, MA. Sticker required. Questions? Call the Transfer Facility 508-478-8093 or 774-737-3117.

DO NOT bag your recycling items in plastic bags.

All items must be clean and empty.

Cardboard must be broken down 2 feet x 2 feet maximum per piece.

One (1) combustible bulk item allowed per week.

Example: wood chair, cloth armchair.

Metal items require a sticker. Available for purchase at the Board of Health.
