June 20, 2023

At 4:30 pm Chairman Kenneth Evans called the meeting to order.

### **Approve Minutes from June 20, 2023**

Leonard Izzo made a motion to approve the minutes, Paul Mazzuchelli seconded, and they were approved unanimously.

### **Approve VNA Contract**

Board member Paul Mazzuchelli asked for clarification in the contract. He wanted to make sure in section II. a. the residents that do not have insurance will still have services and wants a change in section II. c. ii to state that the 6 hours of direct services to the senior center is per week. One other consideration he said is cardiac rehabilitation at the Senior Center in the gym they have upstairs. Leonard Izzo made a motion to accept the contract, Paul Mazzuchelli seconded, and it was approved unanimously.

### **ARPA Funds**

Director Daniel Syriala said the Board of Health has 34,670.83 left in ARPA funds that we must have a plan of how we are going to use it by the end of 2024, and it must be used by the end of 2026. Paul Mazzuchelli said we should think about the services we could provide with these funds.

### **New Director Contract**

Paul Mazzuchelli made a motion to accept the contract for Director Daniel Syriala, Leonard Izzo seconded, and it was approved unanimously.

### **Any other issues the Board Members wish to discuss**

Assistant Director Lisa Tamagni said the office has been inundated with complaints about the condition of the property at 79 Water Street. Paul Mazzuchelli said it is imperative we clean it now. He said it is not fair to the property owners that abut this property. Paul was going to find out from the town council if the town could put a lean on the property so The Board of Health can have it cleaned up.
