Work on the Museum Inventory Listing is an on-going project as we receive donations. Bob will copy the current file onto a flash drive.

We received the flag presented to the family of WWII Veteran Anthony Bufalo at his memorial service. Ron placed it on top of one of our military display cases. Also, Peter Mazzini donated some yearbooks.

Robin Philbin's photos are being sorted and placed in the new display stand that we purchased from WB Mason. Marsha has been a great help with this project along with other members.

Among Robin's donations were several noteworthy items. One was a booklet showing Milford Pink Granite that was used the statue of General Lafayette in Paris, France, the Nathan Hale statue in New York, the Robert Gould Shaw Memorial in Boston, and Madison Square Garden in New York City.

Among the pictures there was one of the Milford soldiers who were killed in the Spanish American War 1898-1902. We had the names previously but not a picture.

Motion to adjourn was made by Pam Fields, seconded by Mary Villani. Motion was unanimous. The next scheduled meeting is May 10, 2023, at 7 pm in Memorial Hall.
