Our budget balance was \$707.83. Now, we are purchasing another rotating display stand, an acrylic display box, a roll of stamps, a case of paper and office supplies. This will leave a balance of \$138.97.

Other items were, an 1870 framed map of Milford from Giancarlo BonTempo, a Memorial flag from Anthony Buffalo and MHS Commencement booklets dating 1928, 29 and 32 from Don Danforth.


