

HISTORICAL COMMISSION OF MILFORD

The Milford Historical Commission meeting of April 9, 2014 was called to order at 7:02 pm in Memorial Hall by Robert Andreola, Chairman. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Pam Fields, seconded by Mary Villani. Motion was unanimous.

A moment of silence was held in memory of John Lowney who was a very knowledgeable and dedicated Associate Commissioner who will be greatly missed.

Lyn and Anne were guest speakers this month at the Trinity Church for their 150 anniversary tea and Cornerstones which is Milford's new assisted living facility.

Van Lucier sent pictures of the hurricane of '38 and Susan Tabor emailed vintage pictures of Milford around 1900. Terrie Moschelli donated a 1950 picture of the graduation class, a 1919 Oak Lily and Ivy and offered us a 1926 Remington typewriter that she will drop off on a Thursday.

We will get prices on reprinting packages of note paper with Memorial Hall sketched on the front with envelopes from Jet Press.

A quarry walk is planned for Saturday, June 14 with a rain date of the 15th and a lawn gathering at the North Purchase District School in August. Pam suggested that we ask people to bring a canned good for the food pantry at our October open house.
