Carlos Benjamin and Rick Villani will check the ceiling in the Museum where the plaster needs repair and painting. Question is whether activity upstairs could be damaging the plaster.

A public presentation by Harriman regarding a Downtown Housing Planning Study was held recently. The idea is to see Main Street and Central Street become a "Destination." The Main Street would be both retail and residential making use of existing space on upper floors of some buildings.

FYI, the Doughboy monument was dedicated 100 years ago on November 11, 1921. Visitors from the Whitcomb House toured the Museum this month as well as several other people
