Proposed Electric Bicycle By-Laws for Milford Bicycle Paths and Trails

Definitions:

- 1. Electric Bicycle A pedal bicycle which has a helper motor.
- 2. Class 2 Electric Bicycle An electric bicycle or tricycle equipped with a motor that may be used exclusively to propel the bicycle and that is not capable of providing assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of 20 miles per hour.

Use:

Electric Bicycles are permitted upon or within a Town of Milford Bicycle Paths. E-Bikes shall not be operated on a trail designated for nonmotorized traffic if such trail has a natural surface tread made by clearing and grading the soil and no surfacing materials have been added.

Electric Bicycles are permitted Class 2 and below and speeds must be kept low, below 15 mph.
