- 2. Milford Upper Charles Trail Comprehensive Maintenance Report (September 2018): Chairman DeLuzio reviewed the report with the Committee. Following some questions and discussion Mr. Arcudi moved to accept the Report as presented, seconded by Mr. Papuga. Passed unanimously.
- 3. Fund Balance Expenditure Program Status: Chairman DeLuzio presented the attached status. He reported that the Bank Stabilization loam and hydroseeding did not turn out as expected. Much of the grass did not survive. The Town supplied the loam. Mike Bresciani contacted Roy landscaping who did the work. Bruce Roy visited the site. Waiting cause of failure report (e.g. loam, defective seed, lack of water, etc.), remedial recommendation, costs and who pays.

Reno requested the flexibility to use some of the remaining \$8,000 for the Open Items as noted. It was moved and seconded to approve this use of funds. Passed unanimously.
