2020 Census Complete Count Committee Invitation

Purpose: To educate community leaders and stakeholders about the 2020 Census process. It is important *all* residents are counted. It is equally important all residents feel comfortable and safe knowing how their information will be stored and used.

Who: Hosted by the Milford Town Clerks' Office in conjunction with the US Census Bureau.

What: A gathering of members of our local government, community leaders and stakeholders to hear directly from the US Census Bureau on how/when the 2020 Census will be conducted in Massachusetts.

Where: Upper Town Hall, 52 Main Street, Milford, MA 01757.

Why: Recording a comprehensive Census count is important because the Federal Census establishes City/Town federal and state funding proportions. Such funding supports public services like fire, health care, library, police, roads, schools, social services, etc.

Only every 10 years is there an opportunity to re-set the count through the Federal Census. Communities with the most complete counts will receive the most funding to better enable cities and town to fully serve their residents.

What else: Our definition of Community Leader/Stakeholder: A member of local government and groups/organizations through which information may be shared/spread to gain community-wide education.
