## First order of Business

1) Steps of having band concerts at plains park- Jim informed commissioners of work that was done in collaboration with Board of Health and Claflin hill to assure concerts could run smoothly. Those of which included: meeting with Jackie Murphy, we came up with plan for grids marked out in grass to promote social distancing. Hand sanitizing stations, Porto jons (with hand sanitizers) to be cleaned twice a week, added signage for field areas stating carry in carry out and practice social distancing. The police will have 2 auxiliary police to assist with traffic flow coming from cedar street. The Claflin hill will promote concerts on web page offering tickets to reserve spot to enter. Only those who register can enter, at no charge. There will be a list of those registered at gate to be checked by park employee, if name on list enter, if not person will not be able to enter. This procedure put in place to insure we keep number of attendees under 100 which follows state guidelines.

Jim will be in contact with Board of health weekly. If anything changes in condition in state, concerts will be revisited to make necessary adjustments to follow state guidelines.
