Location approximately as shown on plan attached.



Dear Mr. DaSilva:

Please take notice that the Select Board will hold a hearing pursuant to G. L.c. 138, section 64, and other applicable law at 6:45 PM in Room 03, Milford Town Hall, 52 Main Street, Milford, MA on Monday, May 6, 2024 at which hearing the Select Board will consider whether or not to modify, suspend, or revoke the license issued for your establishment pursuant to said chapter 138.

The reasons for the contemplated action are as follows:

* On April 17, 2024, at approximately 11:12 PM, the Milford Police Patrol Division were dispatched to your establishment for a male party refusing to pay his tab. Upon arrival, the male fled from Officers on foot and was unable to be located. At approximately 11:39 p.m. Milford Police Dispatch broadcasted a BOLO for an erratic operator driving on Main St with three tires. The vehicle was able to enter Hopedale where Hopedale PD stopped the vehicle on Rte. 16 @ Fitzgerald St. Milford Detective Sergeant, Kevin O'Loughlin, continued to this traffic stop to assist. Upon arrival he observed MA 4DAF48 with heavy damage to the front passengers' side, and drivers' side of the vehicle (missing two tires). The male party, identified as STANLEY PA TRIKE DA SILVA, was sitting in the drivers' seat covered in vomit, matching the description of the male that fled from Central Sports Bar and Grill. Hopedale PD arrested DA SILVA for OUI Liquor, Negligent Operation of a Motor Vehicle, and Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle (24-66-AR Hopedale PD). DA SILVA was charged by Officer B Sanchioni as well for his Milford incident. In booking, Sergeant Francesconi assisted Hopedale PD with translation. Sergeant Francesconi advised O'Loughlin that DA SILVA admitted to being at Central Sports Bar and Grill before departing. DA SILVA stated he drank three Heineken Beers at Central Sports Bar and Grill before leaving. DA SILVA blew a .16 on the PBT, and ultimately was transported to the Milford Regional Hospital from Hopedale PD for his heavy level of intoxication. DA SILVA was clearly over served.

As the owner or manager of your establishment, you are responsible for events that occur in your establishment or on your premises, whether they are planned or unplanned events and whether you are present or not present at the time such events occurred.

Section 1.01 of the Town General Rules Applicable to All Premises Licensed for the Sale of Alcoholic beverages to be consumed on the premises provides that "as a licensee it is your obligation to ensure that a high degree of supervision is exercised over the conduct of the licensed established at all times". "As a licensee you will be held accountable for all violations that are related to the licensed premises to determine whether or not the licensee acted properly in the given circumstances". Further, Section 1.03 states it is your responsibility to "ensure that illegal activities do not occur at the licensed premises." You should "call for police assistance as necessary to ……… to uncover unlawful conduct…and providing police with requested information."

In summary, please be advised that, as a holder of a liquor license issued by the Town of Milford, you are required to comply with and adhere to all relevant Massachusetts General Laws as well as the Town of Milford Board of Selectmen, GENERAL RULES APPLICABLE TO ALL PREMISES LICENSED FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGES TO BE CONSUMED ON THE PREMISES. Failure to do so, could result in modification, suspension, or revocation of the license issued to your establishment.

Attached are the Police Reports filed for the incidents referenced in this Notice.



AMENDMENT TO THE FIRST AMENDED HOST COMMUNITY AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the First Amended Host Community Agreement dated February 16, 2023 (the "Agreement") is entered into this 6th day of May 2024, by and between Sira Naturals, Inc., A Massachusetts corporation with a usual place of business located at 9 Industrial Rd, Milford, MA 01757, (the "Operator") and the Town of Milford, a Massachusetts municipal corporation with a principal address at 52 Main St., Milford, MA 01757 (the "Town").

WHEREAS, the Operator and Town entered into a Host Community Agreement on March 12, 2018, which was subsequently amended on September 10, 2018, and September 23, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Operator and the Town last entered into an Amended Host Community Agreement on February 16, 2023, for the Town to establish its local control authority under G. L. c. 94G, § 3, following the changes in the Cannabis Equity Legislation of 2022; and

WHEREAS, Operator is an existing licensee with the Cannabis Control Commission and authorized to operate a Medical Marijuana Treatment Center, Marijuana Cultivator, Marijuana Product Manufacturer, and Marijuana Transporter license in the Town of Milford, and has pending a Marijuana Research License application; and

WHEREAS, the Operator intends to enter into a consolidation of its licenses as set forth below, which consolidation will require approval of the Massachusetts Cannabis Control Commission (the "Commission") for the Change of Location. Upon conclusion of the Commission's required regulatory process, the Town will accept and acknowledge the transfers of the licenses to be effective. The Operator will notify the Town of the new effective dates of each license location; and

WHEREAS, the Operator intends to assign the Adult-Use cultivation license currently located at 13 Commercial Way (MC282015), to another party as a successor in interest through a Change of Ownership and Control application with the Commission, which change of Ownership and Control will require the successor to enter into a separate Host Community Agreement with the Town; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the anticipated benefits to certain members of the community, the operation of the Marijuana Establishment may impact Town resources in ways and in a manner not shared by other members of the public.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the provisions of this Agreement, the Operator and the Town agree as follows:

1. The consequential arrangement for the reassignment of licenses to the Milford facilities shall be as follows.

1 Industrial Road:

- Adult Use Cultivation MC282015
- Medical Marijuana Treatment Center RMD 245-C (Cultivation);
- Medical Marijuana Treatment Center RMD 245-P (Production);

5-7 Industrial Road:

- Adult Use Production MP281613
- Adult Use Production- MP281303
- Transporter License MX281310
- Adult Use Cultivation MC283066
- Pending Research License PE281260

13 Commercial Way -

- Adult Use Cultivation MC281252; to remain sited at this address until final
 receipt by a successor in interest of all necessary approvals for the transfer of
 such license by the Town and the Commission, including a change in
 ownership and control of such license from the Commission. If such
 approvals are not received, then the license to remain sited at the current
 location pending further action by the Operator.
- 2. Community Impact Fee. If any costs are imposed upon the Town by the operation of the Marijuana Establishment, then the Town shall determine and document these cost impacts and notify the Operator in writing no later than 30 days following the end of the calendar year of operation, all in accordance with G. L. c. 94G, §3, 2(iii) and any applicable regulations as now or hereinafter promulgated by the Massachusetts Cannabis Control Commission. Any community impact fee shall encompass all payments and obligations between the Town and the Operator, which shall be reasonably related to the actual costs imposed upon the municipality by the operation of the Facility. The community impact fee shall not include any additional payments or obligations, including, but not limited to: monetary payments, in-kind contributions, and charitable contributions by the Operator to the Town or any other organization. Upon receipt of the Town's community impact fee statement, the Operator shall have 30 days in which to review the statement. If the Operator does not accept the Town's proposed impact fee, the parties will enter a 90-day period of good faith dispute resolution negotiations. The Town shall use it best efforts to provide the Operator with necessary documentation to submit to the CCC within 60 days of any of the Operator's license expiration or renewal dates, including submitting evidence of any host community impact costs and fees with their application materials. If there is no resolution, the parties reserve their rights under the statute. Nothing in this section shall preclude the Operator from voluntarily providing organizations with monetary payments, in-kind contributions, and charitable contributions after the execution of the Agreement; provided, however, that it shall not include a promise to make a future monetary payment, in-kind contribution, or charitable contribution.

- 3. Support. The Town agrees to submit to the CCC certification of compliance with applicable local bylaws relating to the Operator's applications for a Certificate to operate the Facility, where such compliance has been properly met, and to make best efforts to submit such certification within seven (7) days of any such request by Operator and/or the CCC. The Town agrees to use reasonably best efforts to cooperate with Operator, if approved, to help assist Operator on their community support and employee outreach programs, such assistance shall not be construed to be a guarantee of any Town funding, resources, staff time, or space to facilitate these community support and employee outreach programs.
- 4. Hiring of Milford Residents. When hiring workers for available positions at the Marijuana Establishment, the applicant shall use best efforts to hire workers for those positions as follows: first, qualified residents of the Town of Milford; and then, if workers cannot be obtained in sufficient numbers, positions may be open other qualified workers. In furtherance of this commitment the applicant shall work in concert with local work force organizations and programs to inform the community and to help identify Milford residents who have or can acquire the appropriate training, skills and work experience to work for the applicant.
- Town's Regulatory Authority. This Agreement does not affect, limit, or control the 5. authority of Town boards, commissions, and departments to carry out their respective powers and duties to decide upon and to issue, or deny, applicable permits, including but not limited to, building permits, and other approvals under the statutes and regulations of the Commonwealth, the General and Zoning Bylaws of the Town, or applicable regulations of those boards, commissions, and departments, or to enforce said statutes, ordinances, and regulations. The Town, by entering into this Agreement, is not thereby required, or obligated, to issue such permits and approvals as may be necessary for the Operator to operate the Facility in the Town, or to refrain from any enforcement action against the Operator for violation of the terms of said permits and approvals or said statutes, ordinances, and regulations with respect to the Facility. The Town, however, agrees that the operator may locate all or a part of any of its Marijuana Establishments licenses as the same are provided for herein for medical and/or adult use at any or all of 13 Commercial Way, One Industrial Road, and/or 5-7 Industrial Road, all of which are located in Milford, Massachusetts.
- 6. Term and Termination. This Agreement shall take effect upon execution by the Parties. This agreement shall continue in effect for so long as Operator operates the Facility or any similar Facility within the Town or 8 years after the date set forth below in sub-paragraph c., whichever shall occur first, except that the Parties acknowledge and accept that, in accordance with M.G. L. ch. 94G, Sec. 3(2)(i) as the same may be amended from time to time, no host community agreement shall include a community fee after the eighth year of operation of the Facility.

For determination of the of the above eight-year term, the parties agree that the

date of commencement of operation at each building constituting the Facility is as follows:

a. 13 Commercial Way: June 5, 2019;

b. One Industrial Road: January 23, 2020; andc. 5-7 Industrial Road: November 14, 2022.

At the conclusion of the term of this Agreement, the parties may renegotiate a new Host Community Agreement in accordance with the current prevailing regulations and laws as such regulations and laws may be amended or replaced. In the event Operator no longer does business in the Town or in any way loses or has its license revoked by the Commonwealth, this Agreement shall become null and void. To the extent the Cannabis Control Commission issues or amends its regulations with respect to the provisions of M.G. L. c. 94G, Sec. 3, to establish minimum acceptable standards for host communities, the Parties agree to evaluate the terms of this Agreement in accordance with said regulations and amend this Agreement as may be required by the same.

- 7. Notices. Except as otherwise provided herein, any notices, consents, demands, request, approvals or other communications required or permitted under this Agreement shall be writing and delivered by electronic transmission, in hand, or mailed postage prepaid, return receipt requested, by registered or certified mail, or by other reputable delivery service, and shall be effective upon receipt in hand or by said delivery, and three days after mailing, to the other Party at the following addresses:

- 8. Third Parties. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall create a contractual relationship with or a cause of action in favor of a third party against either the Town or Operator.
- 9. Successors/Assigns. This Agreement is binding upon the parties hereto, their successors, assigns and legal representatives. This Agreement may be transferred by the Operator in whole or in part as it is applicable to any or all the locations constituting the Facility to a new Marijuana Establishment operator, but that new Operator will need to secure a new or amended special permit from the special permit granting authority and other such approvals as may be applicable. If the Agreement transfers as to a location, all requirements of the Operator as to that location shall be transferred to the new location and/or operator. The Parties shall be always prohibited from Assigning, in whole or in part, any portion of the Agreement without written consent of the other party. Operator shall not assign, sublet, or otherwise transfer its rights nor delegate its obligations under this Agreement, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent from the Town, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld.
 - 10. No Joint Venture. The Parties hereto agree that nothing contained in this Agreement, or any other documents executed in connection herewith is intended or shall be construed to establish the Town, or the Town and any other successor, affiliate or corporate entity as joint ventures or partners.
- 11. <u>Confidentiality.</u> Operator may provide to the Town, certain financial information, investment materials, products, plans, documents, details of

company history, know-how, trade secrets, and other nonpublic information related to Operator, its affiliates, and operations (collectively, the "Confidential Information"). Town (inclusive of its employees, agents, representatives or any other of its affiliated persons) shall not, at any time during the term of this Agreement or at any time thereafter, disclose to any person or entity, any Confidential Information, except as may be required by court order or law. To the extent it wishes to so delegate, Operator shall mark each plan, page, or transmission with the word "Confidential." The parties agree that said financial information shall not leave the facility, but that the Town may inspect the information at any time during normal business hours.

- 12. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and venue for any dispute hereunder shall be in the courts of Worcester County.
- 13. <u>Amendments/Waiver.</u> Amendments, or waivers of any term, condition, covenant, duty, or obligation contained in this Agreement may be made only by written amendment executed by all signatories to the original Agreement, prior to the effective date of the amendment.
- 14. Severability. If any term or condition of the Agreement or any application thereof shall to any extent be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by the court of competent jurisdiction or regulatory authority, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining terms and conditions of this Agreement shall not be deemed affected thereby unless one or both parties would be substantially or materially prejudiced. Operator agrees it will not challenge, in any jurisdiction, the enforceability of any provision included in this Agreement; and to the extent the validity of this Agreement is challenged by Operator in a court of competent jurisdiction, Operator shall pay for all reasonable fees and costs incurred by the Town in enforcing this Agreement.
- 15. <u>Headlines.</u> The article, section, and paragraph headings in this Agreement are for convenience only, are no part of the Agreement and shall not affect the interpretation of this Agreement.
- 16. Counterparts. This Agreement may be signed in any number of counterparts all of which taken together, shall constitute the same instrument, and any party hereto may execute this Agreement by signing one or more counterparts.
- 17. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire integrated agreement between the parties with respect to the matters described. This Agreement supersedes all prior agreements, negotiations, and representations, either written or oral, and it shall not be modified or amended except by a written document executed by the parties hereto.

This Agreement does not affect, limit, or control the authority of Town boards, commissions, and departments to carry out their respective powers and duties to decide upon and to issue, or deny, applicable permits, including but not limited to, building permits, and other approvals under the statutes and regulations of the Commonwealth, the General and Zoning Bylaws of the Town, or applicable regulations of those boards, commissions, and departments, or to enforce said statutes, ordinances, and regulations. The Town, by entering into this Agreement, is not thereby required, or obligated, to issue such permits and approvals as may be necessary for the Operator to operate the Facility in the Town, or to refrain from any enforcement action against the Operator for violation of the terms of said permits and approvals or said statutes, ordinances, and regulations with respect to the Facility. The Town, however, agrees that the operator may locate all or a part of any of its Marijuana Establishments licenses as the same are provided for herein for adult use at 13 Commercial Way, located in Milford, Massachusetts.
- 5. <u>Term and Termination</u>. This Agreement shall take effect upon execution by the Parties. This agreement shall continue in effect for so long as Operator operates the Facility or any similar Facility within the Town or 8 years after the date set forth below in sub-paragraph c., whichever shall occur first, except that the Parties acknowledge and accept that, in accordance with M,G. L. ch. 94G, Sec. 3(2)(i) as the same may be amended from time to time, no host community agreement shall include a community fee after the eighth year of operation of the Facility.

For determination of the of the above eight-year term, the parties agree that the date of commencement of operation at 13
Commercial Way, Milford, Massachusetts will be:

At the conclusion of the term of this Agreement, the parties may renegotiate a new Host Community Agreement in accordance with the current prevailing regulations and laws as such regulations and laws may be amended or replaced. In the event Operator no longer does business in the Town or in any way loses or has its license revoked by the Commonwealth, this Agreement shall become null and void. To the extent the Cannabis Control Commission issues or amends its regulations with respect to the provisions of M.G. L. c. 94G, Sec. 3, to establish minimum acceptable standards for host communities, the Parties agree to evaluate the terms of this Agreement in accordance with said regulations and amend this Agreement as may be required by the same.

6. Notices. Except as otherwise provided herein, any notices, consents, demands, request, approvals or other communications required or permitted under this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered by electronic transmission, in hand, or mailed postage prepaid return receipt requested, by registered or certified mail, or by other reputable delivery service, and shall be effective upon receipt in hand or by said delivery, and three (3) days after mailing, to the other Party at the following addresses:

- 7. <u>Third Parties</u>. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall create a contractual relationship with or a cause of action in favor of a third party against either the Town or Operator
- 8. Successors/Assigns. This Agreement is binding upon the parties hereto, their successors, assigns and legal representatives. This Agreement may be transferred by the Operator in whole or in part as it is applicable to any or all the locations constituting the Facility to a new Marijuana Establishment operator, but that new Operator will need to secure a new or amended special permit from the special permit granting authority and other such approvals as may be applicable. If the Agreement transfers as to a location, all requirements of the Operator as to that location shall be transferred to the new location and/ or operator. The Parties shall be always prohibited from Assigning, in whole or in part, any portion of the Agreement without written consent of the other party. Operator shall not assign, sublet, or otherwise transfer its rights nor delegate its obligations under this Agreement, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent from the Town, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld.
- 9. No Joint Ventures. The Parties hereto agree that nothing contained in this Agreement, or any other documents executed in connection herewith is intended or shall be construed to establish the Town, or the Town and any other successor, affiliate or corporate entity as joint ventures or partners.

- 10. Confidentiality. Operator may provide to the Town, certain financial information, investment materials, products, plans, documents, details of company history, know-how, trade secrets, and other nonpublic information related to Operator, its affiliates, and operations (collectively, the "Confidential Information"). Town (inclusive of its employees, agents, representatives or any other of its affiliated persons) shall not, at any time during the term of this Agreement or at any time\thereafter, disclose to any person or entity, any Confidential Information, except as may be required by court order or law. To the extent it wishes to so delegate, Operator shall mark each plan, page, or transmission with the word "Confidential." The parties agree that said financial information shall not leave the facility, but that the Town may inspect the information at any time during normal business hours.
- 11. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and venue for any dispute hereunder shall be in the courts of Worcester County.
- 12. <u>Amendments/Waiver</u>. Amendments, or waivers of any term, condition, covenant, duty, or obligation contained in this Agreement may be made only by written amendment executed by all signatories to the original Agreement, prior to the effective date of the amendment.
- 13. Severability. If any term or condition of the Agreement or any application thereof shall to any extent be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by the court of competent jurisdiction or regulatory authority, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining terms and conditions of this Agreement shall not be deemed affected thereby unless one or both parties would be substantially or materially prejudiced. Operator agrees it will not challenge, in any jurisdiction, the enforceability of any provision included in this Agreement; and to the extent the validity of this Agreement is challenged by Operator in a court of competent jurisdiction, Operator shall pay all reasonable fees and costs incurred by the Town in enforcing this Agreement.
- 14. <u>Headlines</u>. The article, section, and paragraph headings in this Agreement are for convenience only, are no part of the Agreement and shall not affect the interpretation of this Agreement.
- 15. Counterparts. This Agreement may be signed in any number of counterparts all of which taken together, shall constitute the same instrument, and any party hereto may execute this Agreement by signing one or more counterparts.
- 16. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire integrated agreement between the parties with respect to the matters described. This Agreement supersedes all prior agreement, negotiations, and representations, either written or oral, and it shall not be modified or amended except by a written document executed by the parties hereto.


