This addendum modifies the Invitation to Bid for the Painting of the Exterior of Town Hall as noted above and below.

INFORMATION:

UNDER SECTION "ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS" THE FOLLOWING INFORAMTION IS TO BE ADDED TO:

Paragraph 1. Contractor is required to follow all procedures mandated per the Mass. RRP regulations contained in 454 CMR 22.00 to remediate lead paint. See Lead Paint Report Prepared by Capital Environmental, LLC attached hereto (Exhibit A).

Paragraph 4. The contractor is to include the price of wood conservation, repair, restoration and replacement in the base bid. If the contractor chooses, they may note the amount carried for wood conservation, repair, restoration and replacement with individual cost associated with unit prices (See Exhibit B).

Paragraph 5. Contractor is to Scrape, Sand, Prep and prime bare wood areas with a fresh start exterior wood primer to be comparable or equivalent with Benjamin Moore Fresh Start Alkyd Primer.

Paragraph 7. Exterior and rear doors are to be painted. Clock face is not included in the scope of work.

Paragraph 8. All existing signage ("TOWN HALL" sign, etc.) and other existing features are to be painted in Kind (gold paint, etc.) and is to be included in the base bid.

Paragraph 9. Contractor is to use Acrylic Latex exterior paint to be comparable or equivalent with Benjamin Moore Ultra Spec Exterior Low Luster Finish, with the colors to be selected by Owner.

New Paragraph 10. The time lines and schedule can be flexible, mid - August start date is acceptable and a 60-day project / work schedule is acceptable. The project is to be completed prior to any low temperatures that could affect the application of the materials.

New Paragraph 11. Add alternate #1 Bid Item – Contractor is to provide a separate Alternate Bid (Price) to Properly clean the gold leaf – Dome and Eagle Finial.

New Paragraph 12. Add Alternate #2 Bid Item - Contractor is to provide a separate Alternate Bid (price) to paint the medallions and gold painted details. The materials are to match the In-Kind materials (of the Medallions & gold painted details).

New Paragraph 13. Add Alternate #3 Bid Item – Contractor is to provide an Alternate Bid (price) to completely "Re-do" the gold leaf Dome and Eagle Finial. This will include the Dome and Eagle Finial to be Gilded with 23.7+ Karat Gold Patent (see Exhibit C).

LEAD PAINT TEST REPORT

Introduction.

Harvard Environmental Services was retained by Capital Environmental to perform lead paint testing at the Milford Town Hall, 52 Main Street, Milford MA. The scope of testing included measurement of the lead content of representative exterior components to assist in planning for repainting the exterior.

Test Methodology.

Testing involved use of a portable X-Ray Fluorescence (XRF) lead paint analyzer to measure the lead concentration in paint. The instrument was model PB200i by Viken Detection. Prior to use, the instrument was tested on ASTM compliant test blocks which contain known concentrations of lead. All readings were within instrument specifications and proper calibration was verified.

Please see Appendix 2 for additional details on the use of X-Ray Fluorescence XRF) analyzers to test for concentrations of lead in paint.

Test Results.



The photo below shows an example of items which contained lead-based paint.

Pb (lead concentration) on wood siding = 13.6 mg/cm2.

Lead concentrations greater than or equal to 1.0 mg/cm2 are considered hazardous per the Mass. Lead-safe Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) regulation.

* Architectural elements:

Quoin - large block stacked vertically at corners and below columns,

Pediment - decorative arch or gabled trim above large windows,

Modillion - bracket-like component at soffit.

Frieze board - trim panel between top of siding and soffit. Black and gold medallions have been mounted vertically within panel sections on the frieze board.

Examples of Lead-Painted Components (continued)



Photo above shows the lower trim at top of foundation. High concentrations of lead were measured at the skirt board, aka water table. Pb = 7.6 mg/cm2.


At the siding, lead paint was found in highest concentrations at the upper level. See photo on first page. Pb = 13.6 mg/cm2 where thick and crazed.



At the lower level, much of the paint has previously been stripped from the face of the clapboards. However, the lead paint which remains is still at a hazardous level. In this photo, some of the partially stripped clapboards are shown. Pb = 1.4 mg/cm2. on the face of the clapboards, Pb = 2.0 mg/cm2. on the lower edges of the boards, where less of the paint has been removed.



At the cornice level, most components contain very high concentrations of lead.



Exceptions are the medallions which are installed vertically on the frieze board. The vertical medallions are relatively new and are lead-free at black disks and gold-colored leaves. Pb = 0.0 mg/cm2.

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Unlike the vertical medallions, the ornate leaf decorations on the soffit are vintage and contain high concentrations of lead. Pb = 28.3 mg/cm2.



The pediments (photo below) contain high concentrations of lead and are in loose and flaking condition. Pb = 25.2 mg/cm2.



Quoins contain high concentrations of lead. and are in loose and flaking condition. Pb = 20.1 mg/cm2.





Window sills and casings contain high levels of lead:


Window sill 4.9 mg/cm2 Window apron 18.2 mg/ cm2.

Main front entry doors contain high concentrations of lead. Doors: Pb = 10.2 mg/cm2. Door casings: Pb = 17.5 mg/ cm2.

Condition of paint: intact at door with crazing at casing.



At the bell tower, high concentrations of lead were found at balusters, walls, columns, corner trim, etc.

Examples of items which do not contain lead paint include: Basement doors at Exterior D side (south) and window sashes, where tested.



Summary of Test Results.

- Lead paint was identified at a large number of surfaces at the exterior of the Town Hall.
- Concentrations of lead in the paint are quite high. Typical concentrations are 10 30 mg/cm2. This is consistent with the age of the building being greater than 150 years.
- Much of the paint is in loose and flaking condition and must be made intact prior to repainting. This will result in a substantial quantity of lead-based paint debris (paint chips) being generated.

Discussion of Test Results.

The presence of lead in the paint on most exterior building components has implications for painting and, more specifically, paint prep, activities. Relevant regulations are focused on:

- protecting workers who may be performing work during renovations,
- protecting the environment from contamination during on-site work and if the paint is removed, during transportation of materials or debris, and
- disposal of materials or debris from demolition or from paint removal.

Protection of workers from lead exposure is addressed by 29 CFR 1926.62, the OSHA Leadin-construction standard. For OSHA compliance, all detectable lead concentrations are relevant for assessing potential exposure of workers to airborne lead particles during demolition and maintenance activities. Without adequate respiratory protection, workers must not be exposed to lead-containing fumes or airborne lead particles in excess of 50 micrograms per cubic meter of air. Airborne particulates may be generated during demolition activities when cutting grinding or ripping lead-painted steel.

Protection of the environment: The EPA's Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) and Massachusetts environmental regulations require that waste generated during projects where lead-based paint is present and will be disposed of is tested for the Toxicity Character-

istic Leacheate Procedure, also called TCLP. TCLP testing is performed to determine whether waste, including construction or demolition debris must be classified as hazardous due to lead content or if it can be disposed in a conventional construction and demolition (C&D) landfill. The regulatory limit for lead toxicity is 5.0 milligrams per liter (mg/L) in a test solution using EPA Method SW846-7420 for lab testing of waste samples.

Recommendations.

When planning paint prep activities, all contractors and their affected employees should be made aware of the presence of lead paint testing results to satisfy the hazard communication requirements set forth by OSHA regulations. Specifically, contractors and subcontractors should be required to comply with OSHA regulations including 29 CFR 1926.62, *Lead Exposure in Construction: Interim Final Rule* and 29 CFR 1926.59, *Hazard Communication for the Construction Industry*. This could be accomplished by providing them with a copy of this report.

Although Massachusetts and EPA regulations for Lead-Safe Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) do not apply directly to the work planned for the Town Hall painting project as the building is neither residential nor a child care facility. However, following the RRP rules would be the best way to protect the painting contractor's workers, town employees, and members of the public who are using the building.

For that reason, it is **highly recommended that the Town require the painting contractor to follow all procedures mandated per the Mass. RRP regulations contained in 454CMR 22.00.** That starts with a requirement that the contractor be trained and certified for Lead-Safe Renovation, Repair and Painting, and be registered as such with the MA Department of Labor Standards. The latest list of Lead-Safe registered firms is posted at <u>mass.gov/dols</u>.

While work is being done, it will be important for the contractor to fully cover the ground adjacent to the building, keep all doors and windows closed while work is performed, contain and collect all paint chips and other debris. The paint debris should be segregated in barrels and marked with the contents. Following all paint prep, the barrels of debris should be made available to Capital Environmental for testing per the Toxicity Characteristic Leacheate Procedure (TCLP) to determine whether it must be disposed of as hazardous waste.

Appendix 1.

Overview of contractor requirements for general compliance with RRP rules.

The following is adapted from EPA guidance materials per <u>http://www.epa.gov/lead/pubs/reno-vation.htm#contractors</u>

As a contractor, you play an important role in helping to prevent lead exposure. Ordinary renovation and maintenance activities can create dust that contains lead. By following the lead-safe work practices, you can prevent lead hazards.

Contractors who perform renovation, repairs, and painting jobs in pre-1978 housing and childoccupied facilities must, before beginning work, provide owners, tenants, and child-care facilities with a copy of EPA's lead hazard information pamphlet <u>Renovate Right: Important Lead</u> <u>Hazard Information for Families, Child Care Providers, and Schools (PDF)</u> (11 pp., 1.1MB) | Contractors must document compliance with this requirement; EPA's <u>pre-renovation disclosure</u> form (PDF) (1 pp., 53K) may be used for this purpose.

Understand that since 2010, Massachusertts and federal law require you to be certified and to use lead-safe work practices. To become certified, renovation contractors must submit an application and fee payment to the Commonwealth of Mass.

Contractors who perform renovation, repairs, and painting jobs should also:

Take training to learn how to perform lead-safe work practices.

- Find a training provider at <u>www.mass.gov.dols</u> that has been accredited by Massachusetts to provide training for renovators under the Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) Program.
- Please note that if you previously completed an eligible renovation training course you may take the 4-hour refresher course instead of the 8-hour initial course from an accredited training provider to become a certified renovator.

Provide a copy of your Massachusetts lead training certificate to your client.

Learn the lead laws that apply to you regarding certification and lead-safe work practices.

Ask your client to share the results of any previously conducted lead tests.

- Keep records to demonstrate that you and your workers have been trained in lead-safe work practices and that you follow lead-safe work practices on the job. To make record keeping easier, you may use the <u>sample record keeping checklist (PDF)</u> (1 pg., 83K) that EPA has developed to help contractors comply with the renovation record keeping requirements that took effect April 22, 2010.

Appendix 2.

Using X-Ray Fluorescence to test for lead in paint.

To obtain a reading, the instrument is placed against the painted component When the trigger is depressed, a shutter opens, exposing the surface to ionization which causes metals present to fluoresce invisibly. The instrument contains a sensitive detector which measures the fluorescence, and analyzes the observed energy pattern to determine the identity and quantity of metals present. Lead content is indicated in real time on a digital display. Concentrations of lead are displayed as milligrams lead per square centimeter. The accuracy of readings is approx. 0.1 mg/ cm2 per standard deviation.

CARPENTRYSECTION 06200 WOODWORK REPAIRS

PART 1 -GENERAL

- 1.1 <u>References</u>
 - A. The General Conditions, Amendments to the General Conditions and Supplementary General Conditions shall be included in and made part of this SECTION.
 - B. Examine all Drawings and all other SECTIONS of the Specifications for requirements affecting the work of this trade.

1.2 Work Included

(

- A. The work required shall consist of all labor, material, tools, appliances, and services to accomplish the following:
 - 1. Repair, conserve and replace as necessary all exterior wood. Note that epoxy products can be used, when appropriate and that epoxy wood filler will beused to completely seal joints.
 - 2. Similarly, after all window sills are stripped and sanded, spread a thin coat of the specified epoxy wood filler over each, carefully filling all fissures and gouges, where needed.

Section 06200 - 1 Woodwork Repairs

- 2.4 <u>Glue</u>
 - A. Glue for piecing new wood into old shall be an internally plasticized resorcinolformaldehyde product approved by the Architect, or a suitable epoxy resin.

2.5 <u>Wood Filler and Epoxy Saturant</u>

- A. Wood Filler and Epoxy Saturant for consolidation of deteriorated wood work shall be as manufactured by Gougeon Brothers, Inc., 706 Martin St., Bay City, MI 48706, and marketed as the WEST SYSTEM. Filler shall consist of 2-part epoxy mixed with phenolic micro balloons.
- B. Other epoxy-based wood fillers or saturants may be acceptable as equals, but must be submitted for approval. <u>Please note:</u> These products are substantially more expensive than conventional fillers and <u>no</u> non-epoxy substitutions will be allowed.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

- 3.1 <u>Wood Conservation</u>
 - A. The intent of the work is to leave all exterior woodwork weathertight, securely fastened, and ready for painting, and to leave all window sills similarly sound.

Some of the work under this Section will need to be done after the painter's surface preparation, so that this Section and Section 09900 will be **very closelycoordinated**.

B. All surfaces and window sills will be inspected by the Town **before** priming, at the conclusion of epoxy work.

Section 06200 - 3 Woodwork Repairs

C. All punky wood will be either replaced or consolidated in place. Consolidation will be as per West System requirements, and will consist of drilling holes, injecting the epoxy consolidation, and closing holes with epoxy wood fillers. Holes will be spaced and dimensioned as recommended in the West System literature.

- D. Deteriorated end grain, open miters and joints, splits, gouges, and other imperfections will be conserved by first brushing the prepared wood surface with epoxy consolident, and then filling in open areas with an epoxy / micro balloon wood filler.
- E. The contractor shall have the option to replace deteriorated features, and must replace all missing woodwork, but new replacement components must exactly match profiles of existing woodwork. Use original pieces to match profiles.
- F. Special attention is drawn to the need to need for re-nailing loos trim.
- G. If parts of an element are replaced, use only the specified waterproof glue or a suitable epoxy to piece-in new components.
- H. Any new wood or any piece which needs to be re-installed needs to back-primed with the special preservative before final installation.

1.01 Work Included

- A. The work required shall consist of all labor, materials, tools, appliances, and services to accomplish the following:
 - 1. Carefully prep entire exterior, including tower, to remove all failed paint coats, and sand raised grain and any remaining paint edges. Strip selected areas or ornamentalitems chemically, as necessary and as specified. Special care will need to be given to window sills, downspouts, and all surfaces of the tower.
 - 2. As carpentry repairs progress on the tower (Section 06200), back prime all new and temporarily removed exterior decorative wood trim prior to reassembly and installation under that section.
 - 3. Fully caulk building exterior prior to repainting. Note that on the tower and on window sills epoxy wood filler will be applied under section 06200 instead of caulking.
 - 4. Paint all exterior woodwork as specified, allowing for a body color, a trim color, and small amounts of one other accent color plus gold paint.
- 1.03 Related Work
 - A. All work in this Manual is part of a closely coordinated single project, to be coordinated by the Roofing Contractor as General Contractor. As he will provide ten-year personal warranty on the watertightness of the tower, work in this area will receive his closest scrutiny.

PART 2 - MATERIALS

2.01 Unless a change in writing is issued by the Architect, all materials shall strictly conform to the following:

A. <u>Paint:</u>

1. Manufacturer:

Benjamin Moore, Milford.

2. <u>Primer:</u>

Benjamin Moore

3. <u>Paint:</u>

Benjamin Moore

- B. <u>Thinners:</u> For Primer, Mineral Spirits, as recommended by manufacturer. For Paint, boiled linseed oil. <u>Clean-up</u>: Mineral Spirits.
- C. <u>Mildew Inhibitor:</u> Two ounces shall be added per gallon of exterior paint, Tenneco Super-Add-It or approved equal. If another product is used, proportions may have to be adjusted to achieve equivalent protection.
- D. <u>Caulking:</u> Shall be an Acrylic Latex product as **recommended by the paint manufacturer**, or "Boat life Life Caulk" polysulfide compound as manufactured by the Flo-Paint Company of Hicksville, New York, or approved equal. Please note that only the very best caulking shall be considered. The primer used for the caulking shall be as specified by the caulking manufacturer.
- E. <u>Special Requirements:</u> The Contractor shall keep on site all empty caulking tubes. These may only be discarded after the Architect makes a final count at Substantial Completion.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

- 3.01 Lead Precautions
 - A. The Contractor's attention is drawn to the fact that some lead paint may still exist below the surface of this old building. Unless the Contractor determines otherwise, the presence of lead should be assumed and the following precautions taken:

Section 09900 - 3

Town Hall Exterior Repainting Milford, Massachusetts

- 1. Follow all OSHA guidelines concerning safety of workmen and proper practices and procedures.
 - 2. Prior to starting work, vacuum up all paint flakes on ground with HEPA vacs, and dispose of this material according to all applicable codes and regulations.
 - 3. Prior to surface prep, put down and fasten polyethylene material 8 feet wide around perimeter of building, to catch scraped flakes. Dispose of material caught therein according to all applicable laws and regulations.
 - 4. Refrain from prep work, scraping or sanding on windy days, as defined by OSHA and all other authorities having jurisdiction. 3.2 <u>Preparation</u> of Surfaces
- A. Brush and scrape all loose paint from the wood, using putty knives and hand wire brushes. No power tools are to be used. Be careful not to pull soft wood grain from surfaces; or in any other way gouge, scar, or splinter wood. Feather all paint edges by hand with sandpaper. Particular attention must be paid to ornaments, which must retain their sharp edges. On such hard-to-reach areas and areas of heavy paint build-up, the use of a paint remover will be permitted. Where rusted nails are present, tamp nail head below surface of adjacent wood siding and caulk over nail head to eliminate rust bleed through. Note that peeling is currently prevalent only at window sills and downspouts.
- B. No heat method of paint removal shall be allowed.
- C. In areas discolored by mildew of mold due to moisture, etc., proper cleaning prior to priming will assure adherence of primer and finish coats to be applied later. Recommended cleaning solution consists of:
 - 1. 3 oz. (2/3 cup) trisodium phosphate cleaner
 - 2. 1 oz. (1/3 cup) detergent
 - 3. 1 qt. 5% sodium hypchlorite bleach
 - 4. 3 qts. warm water (make approx. one gallon)
- D. Under Section 06200, the General Contractor must fill all cracks restoring a smooth and even surface to the wood, and sand as necessary. Follow manufacturer's specifications closely. Once surfaces are prepared, the Contractor shall notify the Architect so that surfaces may be inspected prior to painting. They shall be dry, free of foreign matter, voids, blemishes, and excessive paint build-up.

- E. Architect must be given **one week notice** for each of the following importantinspections:
 - 1. Wood conservation completed
 - 2. Prep work ready for inspecting

Areas may be inspected separately so that Contractor may proceed on those thathave passed inspection.

- 3.03 Exterior Priming and Caulking
 - A. Use drop cloths free of holes to protect all surfaces not to be painted.
 - B. Prime all bare wood surfaces according to manufacturer's specifications. Do not apply paint materials when temperature is below 50 degrees F., or on surfaces in direct sun, or where dust is being generated which would speck the paint. Do notapply in damp or rainy weather.
 - C. After prime coat is dry, caulk around perimeter of all window and door frames, and all other openings on the building exterior. Particular care should be taken tocaulk around projecting ornan1ental woodwork and any other possible avenues of water penetration.
 - D. Secure the approval of the Architect before proceeding.
 - E. Note that primed and approved areas cannot be painted until 48 hours have elapsed since priming. Thereafter, they must be painted within 7 days from when the primer was applied. This schedule will be strictly enforced.
- 3.04 Exterior Painting
 - A. Two finish coats shall be applied over the primer, as per manufacturer's specifications.

B. Brush-apply paint evenly without runs, sags or other defects, each coat shall be thoroughly worked into the material being coated at the average rate of coverage recommended by the material manufacturer for the type surface involved. Coverall surfaces completely to provide uniform color and appearance. All parts of moldings, trim, ornaments, edges and sills shall be left clean and true to details without undue amount of paint in comers or depressions. Make edges of colors sharp and clean, without overlapping.

2.5 <u>Gilding</u>

A. Gilding shall be 23K patent gold applied over sizing.

B. Ground color for area under gold leaf shall be yellow ochre paint. Color shall be as directed by the Architect.

C Sizing for area under gold leaf shall be quick drying goldsize.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 Storage and Use of Materials

A. Materials shall be stored only in designated spaces, in a manner which meets the requirements of applicable fire regulations. Remove oily rags used for cleanup from the premises. Each space where painting materials are being used shall be provided with a dry chemical type fire extinguisher, minimum 10#, rated for A, B & C fires. There will be NO SMOKING inside the building or on the staging.

3.2 Inspection of Surfaces

A. Before proceeding with the application of paint, the Contractor shall inspect all surfaces and shall determine whether surfaces are in suitable condition to receive paint. The Contractor shall notify the Architect of any defects found in the surfaces to receive paint, especially at exterior woodwork, where wood conservation is to be performed by others.

B. Starting of painting operations under this section shall be construed as acceptance of surfaces and any subsequent defects resulting from such accepted surfaces shall be corrected by the Contractor at no additional cost to the Owner.

3.3 Lead Paint

A. During preparation the Contractor shall be aware that there may be lead paint materials on certain sections of the work area.

B. The Contractor shall give all notices required by, and comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, codes and requirements of state and local agencies in performing the work.

C The Contractor shall comply with all local laws and requirements governing the removal, isolation, clean-up and disposal of any hazardous materials associated with lead paint.

3.4 Protection of Surfaces

A. Furnish and lay suitable drop cloths in all areas where painting is being done to protect roofs and all other finished surfaces from damage during work. Use dropcloths for exterior painting to protect roof shingles and wall surfaces, landscaping, paving and exterior features from paint drips.

This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.

An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.

The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.

All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.

The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.

Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.

Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.

Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.

Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
