# Addendum To The Milford Youth Center HVAC Renovation Project Bid Documents

August, 28th 2019

## 1. Regarding Conflicts of terminal unit installation with installed wall-mounted sensors/signage:

The installation locations of the wall mounted terminal VRF units as shown on the drawings represents the general intent of the design engineer. The lateral field adjustment of these units install location to avoid conflicting existing wall fixtures is to be allowed for distances of up to 3ft in either direction.

## 2. Regarding the changes in ventilation of the basement music room:

Dance room alteration to ventilate the music room includes a change in unit specification. The ERV in the dance room shall be upsized to 650CFM of total airflow. The basis of design has been updated to reflect this based on a Renewaire HE1.5XINH.

An updated version of the basement plan to reflect these changes is attached to reflect these changes.

### 3. Regarding CORI requirements for on-site workers:

Under certain circumstances, including the Milford Youth Center Multizone Airconditioning – HVAC Renovation Project, the Town of Milford is required or authorized to conduct criminal history inquires. All those affiliated with this project, who will have an on-site presence at the Milford Youth Center are required to pass a CORI background check prior to the start of the project."

## 4. Regarding the current state of the roof warrantee:

The roof at the Milford Youth Center is currently under manufacturer's warranty by Carlisle. The proposed work involves necessary penetrations to this roof. All roofing work is to be performed by Carlisle Authorized Roofing Applicator. All terms, conditions, and limitations within the Golden Seal Total Roofing System Warranty are to be upheld and carried out by the contracted as related to the project. Warranty documentation is attached to this addendum.

## 5. Regarding slimduct as a means of concealment:

Slimduct is to be used as an acceptable means of concealment of refrigeration pipe in the transition from concealed ceiling or wall refrigeration piping to the terminal VRF unit connection. The use of slimduct is acceptable only in these transitory situations and runs of slimduct concealmed piping are not to exceed 2ft in length.

## 6. Regarding necessary cutting and patching of wall/ceiling construction for the concealment of refrigeration piping and electrical conduit:

The MYC has multiple ceiling types in the ground floor and mezzanine levels. Refrigerant branch piping and associates terminal unit electrical wiring is to be run concealed above the ceiling. The bidder is responsible for all associated cutting and patching of hard ceiling assemblies to facilitate the installation of concealed runs. As the building will be occupied and operation throughout the install period, particular attention to cleanliness and mitigation spread of dust is to be paid to any drywall work associated with the project.

## 7. Regarding ATC-BAS requirements:

VRF systems shall come equipt with manufacturer controls and capability for a future connection to a BAS system via BACnet adapter/card.

## 8. Regarding requirements for duct insulation:

The outdoor air ducts connecting to the ERV units on the basement level are to be insulated.

## 9. Concealed Wiring

Power wiring to all mechanical equipment is to be concealed in the same manner as refrigerant piping on floors 1 and the upper mezzanine level. Exposed power wiring on the basement level is to be run in EMT conduit.

#### 10. Notes on Schedule:


The initial bid document set included on the equipment schedule for the basement units, a section for notes which were not reflected on the drawing. The inclusion of this notes section was an error and has been removed on the attached addendum drawing.

Permit fees will be waived

## 12. Liquidated Damages:

Liquidated damages if not substantially completed by the agreed upon date (approximately October 31, 2019) will be \$300.00 per day.

#### TERMS, CONDITIONS, LIMITATIONS

- Owner shall provide Carlisle with written notice via letter, fax or email within thirty (30) days of the discovery of any leak in the Carlisle Total Roofing System. Owner should send written notice of a leak to Carlisle's Warranty Services Department at the address set forth at the bottom of this warranty, By so notifying Carlisle, the Owner authorizes Carlisle or its designee to investigate the cause of the leak. This warranty shall not be applicable if, upon Carlisle's inspection, Carlisle determines that any of the following has occurred:

- The Carlisle Total Roofing System is damaged by natural disasters, including, but not limited to, lightning, fire, insect infestations, earthquake, tomado, hall, hurricanes, and winds of (3 second) peak gust speeds of fifty-five mph or higher measured at 10 meters above ground; or
- Loss of Integrity of the building envelope and, or structure including, but not limited to partial or complete loss of roof decking, well slding, windows, doors or other envelope components or from roof damage by wind-blown objects, or:

The Carlisle Total Roofing System is damaged by any intentional or negligent acts, accidents, misuse, abuse, vandalism, civil disobedience, or the like.

- Deterioration or failure of building components, including, but not limited to, the roof substrate, walls, mortar, HVAC units, non-Carilsie brand metal work, etc., occurs and causes a leak, or otherwise damages the Carlisle Total Roofing System; or
- Acids, olls, harmful chemicals and the like come in contact with the Carlisle Total Roofing System and cause a leak, or otherwise damage the Carlisle Total Roofing
