



Be it ordered and enacted by the Milford Board of Selectmen,

in light of the current state of emergency in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts declared by Governor Charles D. Baker in response to the novel COVID 19 pandemic, acting pursuant to the executive authority granted to the Board of Selectmen by the General Court, as follows:

1. Effective sunset on Friday, May 1, 2020 the parking lot located at Louisa Lake on Dilla Street, Milford, Massachusetts will be closed to all motor vehicle and pedestrian traffic. No motor vehicles can be parked in the lot at any time. This Executive Order is in direct response to a declared state of emergency, is intended to protect the health and welfare of the residents of Milford and others and shall remain in effect only so long as the state of emergency is in effect.
2. This order supersedes and vacates any prior special, executive, or general orders of any type or source whatever, including those issued by department heads, and takes effect immediately upon its passage.
