## Massachusetts

***Be it ordered and enacted by the Milford Board of Selectmen,***

in light of the current state of emergency in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts declared by Governor Charles D. Baker in response to the novel COVID 19 pandemic, and acting pursuant to the executive authority granted to the Board of Selectmen by section 2 of chapter 53 of the Acts of 2020, which amends subsection (a) of Section 10A of chapter 39 of the General Laws, after consultation with the Town Moderator, Michael Noferi, hereby counsel, recommend, and advise said Town Moderator as follows:

- 1.** To further consult, if necessary, with the Milford Police Chief, the Milford Fire Chief, and the Milford Board of Health, and as appropriate under the current state of emergency, exercise his authority under Section 10A of chapter 39 of the General Laws, to recess and continue the Annual Milford Town Meeting, called pursuant to an issued warrant and currently scheduled for May 18, 2020, for a period of up to, but not more than, thirty (30) days. Said authority is delegated to the Town Moderator during a public health emergency, and for a period of five (5) days after the termination of any public health emergency.
- 2.** Upon recessing and continuing the Annual Milford Town Meeting scheduled for May 18, 2020, to notify the Agent of the Milford Board of Health of such action so that she, in accordance with chapter 53 of the Acts of 2020, may, within ten (10) days after the initial

declaration, submit a report to the Massachusetts Attorney General providing the justification for the declaration.
