



Be it ordered and enacted by the Milford Board of Selectmen,

in light of the current state of emergency in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts declared by Governor Charles D. Baker in response to the novel COVID 19 pandemic, acting pursuant to the executive authority granted to the Board of Selectmen by section 10 of chapter 53 of the Acts of 2020, as follows:

Notwithstanding sections 57, 57A, and 57C of chapter 59 of the General Laws and section 2 of chapter 60A of the General Laws, or any other general or special law to the contrary, as a result of the outbreak of the 2109 novel coronavirus, known as COVID-19, and the declaration of a state of emergency issued by Governor Charles D. Baker on March 10, 2020, the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Milford, Massachusetts hereby waives the payment of interest or other penalty in the event of late payment of any excise tax, betterment assessment or apportionment thereof, sewer rate or annual sewer use or charge added to a tax for any payments with a due date on or before or after March 10, 2020, and made after its respective due date but before June 30, 2020.
