

This will now replace the Winter Parking Ban and will be in effect all year long as needed.

When an Emergency Parking Ban is implemented, the Chief of Police will notify WMRC Radio AM-1490, Boston TV News Stations, the Milford Daily News, The Milford Town Crier and notification will be made via the Town of Milford Connect CTY Notification System. Likewise, when the ban is lifted, notification will be made in the same manner.

The Town of Milford Connect CTY Notification System has residents home telephone numbers. If a resident would like to be notified via their cell phone, text or email, they should go the Milford Police website, milfordpolice.org or milfordpublicsafety.com, click on the Connect CTY icon and enter this information.

No person shall allow, permit or suffer any vehicle, other than one acting in an emergency, or vehicles registered as emergency vehicles to be parked on any street or highway during a declared "Emergency Parking Ban". If a vehicle is found in violation, it shall be prima facie evidence that the person to whom the vehicle is registered or titled is the person who allowed, permitted or suffered said vehicle to be so parked.

The Chief of Police or any officer may issue a parking violation ticket or notice stating the fine for the violation as provided for in Article IX. In addition to any other penalty provided by law, the Chief of Police or any officer may remove said vehicle from the street or highway by ordering that the vehicle be towed to a convenient location. The person to whom the vehicle is registered or titled shall be liable for the charges for the removal, towing and storage of the vehicle.
