## **Town Election:**

The polls will be open for the Annual Town Election on April 4<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 am until 8:00 pm at your normal polling locations

Pr. 1 & 6- Senior Center, 60 North Bow Street Pr. 2 & 3- Italian American Veterans Hall, 4 Hayward Field Pr. 4, 5, 7, 8- Milford Portuguese Club, 119 Prospect Heights.

Unofficial results will be posted Election night (after 8:00 pm) and winning candidates will be notified by mail after the election. This includes all Elected positions and Town Meeting Member seats.

## **Dog Licenses:**

Dog licenses are issued at the Town Clerk's Office. Our 2023 licensing period runs from April 1<sup>st</sup> - June 30<sup>th</sup> each year.

If you have a new puppy/dog, please register the puppy/dog after it receives its rabies vaccination (you will need to provide our office a copy of the rabies certificate). Copies of spay/neutering certificates will also be required for all new puppies/dogs if applicable. Those pet owners who are renewing their dog licenses from the previous year will only need to present us a spay/neutering certificate if the surgery for spay/neutering was done after you have registered your dog in 2023.

We will also need a new/valid rabies certificate if a previous one has expired. The cost of our dog licenses is \$6.00 per Spay/Neutered Dogs and \$25.00 per Female/Male Intact Dogs.

The Board of Health is offering a Rabies Clinic at the Milford Highway Barn on April 8<sup>th</sup>. Dogs 1:30pm-2:30pm and 2:30pm – 3:00pm for Cats The cost is \$20.00 per Dog/Cat **The Town Clerk's Office will be on hand for licensing at the same time.**
