What's Happening Now at the Town Clerk's Office:

Registering to Vote for the November 6th Election:

The Deadline to Register to Vote is Wednesday, October 17, 2018 by 8:00 pm in the Town Clerk's Office at Town Hall. You can verify if you are registered or not on www.sec.state.ma.us/e/e/.

Absentee Ballots for the November 6th Election:

You are currently able to apply for an Absentee Ballot for yourself or a family member if they will be unable to make it to their polling location on November 6th. Ballots will be mailed to them as soon as we receive them. Applications can be found on www.sec.state.ma.us/e/e/.

If you need to be added to our "permanent" absentee list, you would provide our office a letter from your Physician stating you are unable to vote at your polling location due to health reasons along with your Absentee ballot application.

Early Voting for the November 6th Election:

Early Voting will take place at Town Hall (52 Main Street, Milford) starting October 22, 2018 and run until November 2, 2018. The dates and hours are as follows:

October 22-October 26	8:30 am until 5:00 pm
October 27	9:00 am until 12:00 pm
October 29- November 2	8:30 am until 5:00 pm

State Election, November 6, 2018:

Polling hours for this Election will be from 7:00 am until 8:00 pm.

Precincts 1 & 6 will vote at the Senior Center, 60 North Bow St.

Precincts 2 & 3 will vote at the Italian Veterans Hall, 4 Hayward Field

Precincts 4, 5, 7, 8 will vote at the Milford Portuguese Club, 119 Prospect Heights
