Upcoming Election Information:

Please be advised that the Town of Milford is required to provide EARLY VOTING IN PERSON and the DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE for the following 2022 Election.

All sessions will be held at Milford Town Hall, 52 Main Street, in the upper hall (accessible from the double doors on Main Street).

Accessible parking and the accessible entrance are on the right-hand side of building and an elevator can be used to access Upper Town Hall.

The general entrance to access Upper Town Hall is in the front of the building on Main Street.

Tuesday 11/1 Early Vote in Person 8am-4:30pm
Wednesday 11/2 Early Vote in Person 8am-6:00pm
Thursday 11/3 Early Vote in Person 8am-4:30pm
Friday 11/4 Early Vote in Person 8am-11:30am

Early Voting by Mail is available for the November 8th State Election. Yyou may have already received an application in the mail for the last election that could be used for all elections in 2022. Please do not resubmit a duplicate application! If you are submitting an application for the first time, please do so as quickly as possible as the Post Office suggests two weeks for mailing.

Please note that due to staffing shortages, the Town Clerk's Office will be open for Election related business ONLY during Early Voting sessions and on Election Days. Please see the

Who are my Candidates?

Election Day(s):

Voting will NOT be at Town Hall on Election Day but at your normal polling location. Polls will be open 7:00 am until 8:00 pm on Election Day (November 8th).

You can vote in person on Election Day at your Polling location:

Precincts 1 & 6- Milford Senior Center, 60 North Bow St.

Precincts 2 & 3- Italian American Veterans Hall, 4 Hayward Field

Precincts 4, 5, 7, 8- Milford Portuguese Club, 119 Prospect Heights

If you will be unable to make it to your polling location on Election Day between 7:00 am and 8:00 pm please apply for an Early Voting by Mail Ballot using the following link **as soon as possible.
