 - > One member notes federal banks are required to donate to charity.
 - c. YMCA Mobile Food Pantry continues!
 - Monthly provides one bag of groceries which included PanMass leftovers
 - ➤ Members had a "Meet & Greet" with Congressman, Jake Auchencloss
- 2. After School Program:
 - a. Open House: Wednesday, August 30th from 4:00-6:00 pm
 - > Encourage Milford community to attend, enjoy tours, meet MYC Board members!
 - b. September 5th 1st Day!
 - c. We are hiring!
 - > MYC hires kids from YouthWorks or 16 years or older from After School program
- 3. Building Updates:
 - a. Renovation:
 - > Jay, Carlos, and Rick Villani attended the 8/2/23 Meeting
 - Proposals are on the table
 - > Exploring remediation options and estimates on mock-up for southside of building
 - b. Music/Multipurpose Media Center State Rep, Brian Murray secured \$60,000 State earmark, and passed over Town Meeting Article; secured in the House budget and now in the Conference Committee Review stage
 - > State earmark must be redrafted and signed by the Governor but was not cut from the House budget.
 - ➤ A. Calagione said MYC can count on the Recovery money again next year.

 - b. 60 backpacks to be distributed from UWTC United Way and YMCA
 - c. YouthWorks Program up and running
 - 27 youth at 12 locations helping out at the Senior Center for month of August!
 - The program has become well respected as a support by Town administration. They're asking for MYC staff when there are shortages at the Senior Center.
 - d. AmeriCorps position Interviewed second applicant
 - > Two positions for Front Desk coverage one funded by MYC, one by the Town
 - > New HR Director is interviewing candidates with MYC staff
 - ➤ Third person to be interviewed this week

- Could start Youth Council earlier
