- Sponsored programs by Milford Hospital
- Social Emotional Program grant funded (Landon and Iliana)
- d. Two AmeriCorps' members will attend Open Houses in all schools (outreach)!
- 2. Building Updates:
  - a. Music/Multipurpose Media Center State Rep, Brian Murray secured \$60,000 State funding waiting on receipt date for funding
  - b. Block funding secured by the Town pursuing crosswalk signage.
    - > Town awarded a grant. MYC will be accessed via Winter St. rather than Pearl St.
  - c. Capital Plan/Town Meeting: October 30, 2023 12-15 passenger van approved
    - ➤ Imperial \$6,500 quote; follow-up has gone unanswered for 3 years.
    - > YMCA shared how they purchase vans. They will research other vendors and pricing to secure a better estimate for the Town.
    - Could a van be purchased as part of another Town department's fleet division?
    - ➤ The van would be multipurpose (transportation to Milford TV, transport supplies).
    - > Reco money The \$10,000 earmark will be announced at CraftRoots fundraiser.
