**Milford Youth Commission Minutes**  
**June 8, 2015**

Meeting called to order by Susan Salamone at 7:12 pm.

- Welcome to Jeff Niro, the new Financial Liaison for the Milford Youth Center.
- Senator Fattman was invited to this meeting, but he was unable to make it due to a prior commitment. We will continue to invite him to a meeting.
- Warrants for approval and signatures including the rent invoice and the scholarship.
- Motion by Amy Tamagni, seconded by Mike Walsh, and all in favor to approve the May 4, 2015 minutes. (Chuck Calagione abstained as he was not present for that meeting.)
- Current balance in the revolving account is \$68,286.22.  
\$27,929.02 from the Revolving Account will be transferred into State Grant Account for the salary and wages of Jennifer Ward from the period of 12/30/14 to 6/10/2015.
- Representative Fernandes is pushing for \$50,000 in next year's House of Representatives Budget to go to the Milford Youth Center.
- Renovation Update: There is only one of the larger pavers left and ten 4 x 8 bricks. The next Renovation Committee meeting will be held on Wednesday June 10, 2015 at 7:00 pm.
- The kids had a tour of the building and conducted an interview for Milford TV. The MYC/JAG Relay for Life Team raised over \$4,000 for the American Cancer Society. The end of the year party will be held on June 19<sup>th</sup>. The Seaver Scholarships will be given out at this event. The New Hope/5K was cancelled. The June schedule was distributed.
- There will be a max of 20 campers for the summer camp the month of July. Four to six summer camp staff will be hired. The Humanitarian Aid Summit will provide lunches two to three days per week. A

RICHO will sponsor a youth to the summer camp. Mass Rehab will have three students for 15 hours per week.
