Milford Youth Commission Minutes March 7, 2016

- Meeting called to order by Sidney De Jesus at 6:35 pm.
- Introduction of Mackenzie Fitzpatrick the SCI AmeriCorps member.
- Warrants for approval and signatures.
- The fund balance for revolving account as of 02/29/2016 was \$60,583.18.
- Renovation Committee will next meet Thursday March 10, 2016 at 7:00 pm
- Motion by Amy Tamagni to approve the 02/01/2016 minutes. Seconded by Susan Salamone and all in favor.
- Motion by Amy Tamagni to approve using \$5,000 in additional to the previously approved \$20,000 to fix the leaking radiators, seconded by Mike Walsh, and all in favor.
- The original plan was to start moving into the building at the end of March; however, that is no longer an option due to the needed repairs to the radiators. Move in date to be announced.
- The grand reopening of the building will be held on May 14th to coincide with the Celebrate Milford event scheduled. The rain date will be the same as the town event. The "Dressed Up, Not Messed Up" fashion show will be held that night.
- Presentation of the sign in system Myseniorsystem. This is currently used at the Senior Center.
 Discussion of how this system can be used at the youth center.

- A refrigerator, stove and a dishwasher are still needed for the new kitchen. Counter tops are also needed. The program is exploring different opportunities for funding or donations. Discussion of possible places to donate these items.
